- I state my main point clearly at the beginning.
- I set a steady direction in the introduction.
- I keep each paragraph focused on a single idea.
- I support my overall point in every section.
- I give the conclusion a complete and satisfying finish.
- I place my ideas in an order that feels natural to follow.
- I build each sentence with a clear subject and verb.
- I keep the meaning easy to understand.
- I use active voice where it strengthens the sentence.
- I remove filler words that add no value.
- I avoid repetition unless it serves a purpose.
- I shorten long phrases that slow the pace.
- I keep the tone steady throughout the draft.
- I check that every word is spelled correctly.
- I keep punctuation consistent with the required style.
- I match each subject with the correct verb form.
- I keep the tense consistent from start to finish.
- I follow the correct citation format.
- I read the paper aloud to catch awkward spots.
- I confirm that the final version feels complete and polished.
