LICENSING: for the January Sebring Test

Drivers must have a Competition license or Valid Novice Permit issued by: FRP; SCCA; FIA;
HSR; IMSA; NASA; VRG; EMRA; Indy Car; or CACC.

At Sebring only - Expired 2025 licenses will be accepted

Lucas Oil or Skippy School graduates are eligible for the FRP License.

TIRES: There are no Tire restrictions at this testing, run what you like.

Hoosier - There WILL NOT be any Hoosier tire support at this event. Order tires from Hoosier directly (abatton@hoosiertire.com) early enough to have them shipped. If you are attending either of the SCCA Majors races (Homestead and Sebring) Hoosier may be able to send them on the truck - **Check with Adam sooner than later.**

FUEL: Sebring has 93, 98, 110 & 112 octane available, but fuel is open - buy anywhere.

This will be a great opportunity to shake down cars, drivers and crew; do some real testing in a relaxed setting without the stress of a race weekend.



GET A JUMP ON YOUR 2026 SEASON CREDENTIALS!

DRIVERS -- you MUST HAVE the FRP PRO License by your 2nd regular season event.
CREW -- The FRP Crew Hard card is available at no charge - it is STRONGLY Recommended (It will make your life easier!!!)

The FRP Pro License Application & The FRP Crew Hardcard - Application Links - will be available Early January on the FRP Website: racefrp.com.

- The FRP Pro 2026 License Cost is (\$150).
- FRP Licensing is automatic for holders of a recent competition license, and Lucas Oil or Skippy School graduates.
Other applicants will be reviewed for eligibility by FRP with a racing resume.
- FRP always retains the right to determine qualifications, and deny entry, of drivers regardless of license held.

DRIVERS, CREW, & GUESTS - Everyone must sign a *Racing America* WAIVER.
Anyone found in a hot pit area without proper credentials may be fined \$500 (and/or ejected from the event), and this fine will accrue to the associated team.

The Annual Waiver is signed as part of the FRP Pro Driver's License & Crew Hard Card Applications. IF you do not have the FRP Pro License or FRP Crew Hardcard, you will be required to sign a online waiver at EACH EVENT.

For 2026 - Crew Members & Guests have their own FRP registration site that works for the whole season. USE THIS LINK: [FRP 2026 Crew Registration](#)

(Driver & Crew Chief Info is captured through the Driver registration on Motorsport Reg.) If you want your Crew and Guests to receive event emails and track session results, it is Important to have them register directly using this form.
You can also sign up crew yourself.

Every Participant entering grounds of every track venue must ALSO sign the specific track's waiver, sometimes available online, sometimes only at the gate.
Each track will have a specific wrist band for the weekend, which provides one with continual weekend access.

Everyone MUST check in at FRP's At-Track Registration before going on track or into the Hot Pits.
