In a few days we will be seeing you in snowy, or sunny Florida!

Here are a few details to make this FRP test event at Sebring go smoothly.

We are hosted by Trans-Am, and their ownership group now known as Racing America.

However, for this event, FRP is sanctioned and insured through USAC.
(Driver info follows below)

There are 3 (Three) waivers that must be signed for this event.

1. **The Racing America Guest Waiver** - ONLINE- MUST be Done ASAP!
2. **The USAC Waiver**, Online or paper at the track
3. **The Sebring Track Waiver** (paper at the gate)

The only thing Everyone must do BEFORE arriving is sign the online Racing America Guest Waiver. Please do this **NOW** so you get on the Racing America Participant list.

Procedures:

- You will sign a Sebring track waiver at the gate to enter the premises.
- You **MUST** also come to the FRP registration at the series rig.
- Your signed Racing America Waiver must be verified.
- The USAC waiver must be verified or signed.
- You will receive an event wrist band

Please bring verification you have signed online waivers with you, or you will have to sign them again and be delayed.

EVERYONE must sign all waivers and have an event wrist band - **EVEN** if you are not going into the **HOT PITS**. DIRE consequences to be had if you are found wandering about anywhere on premises without this wrist band....

Without the wrist band you will not be allowed on track and ejected from the Hot Pits.

LOAD-IN

Tuesday Jan 20 -

Staging is at Gate 4 - Carroll Shelby Blvd - on the Skid pad.

Earliest arrival allowed is 10:00am

Load-In: 5:00pm - 7:00pm - FRP staff will Direct FRP rigs.

Load Out: Thursday, January 22nd by 7:00 PM - This is a hard time.

DRIVERS

Every driver will be issued a (No Charge) weekend USAC license.

For those drivers who are registered, your license has been approved and we will deal with any licensing paperwork at the FRP at-track Registration.

IF you are planing to drive, and have not yet registered on Motorsport Reg, it is best to do it NOW... Also, if you are planning on crewing for someone who has not yet registered on Mortorsport Reg — best do encourage them to register NOW.

CIRCUIT DETAILS

Length of Circuit/Turns: 3.74 miles | 17 turn road course

Race Direction: Clockwise

Start & Finish Line: Pit Straight

Pit Lane Speed: 40 mph. Pay attention to your speed.

Pit Lane Entrance: There will be no official grid at this event.

To go on-track, all cars must proceed through the paddock, towards the bridge, then to pit lane via the crossroad that runs between the paddock near the bridge, and the pit lane, near pit in. This road will be a one-way road from the paddock to pit lane. Cars waiting to go on-track must line up to the left by pit out, or in their chosen pit box. When the track is open, a pit lane marshal will direct cars onto the track.

Pit Lane Exit: The exit road at the end of pit lane will be a one-way road from pit lane back to the paddock area.

Pit Lane Attire: Shirts with sleeves, closed toed shoes, and long pants are required in pit lane.

Black Flag Locations: Turns 10, 15, and Start/Finish

Track Security: See Sebring Security at the front gate.

Quiet Hours: No race engines between 8:00 pm and 8:00 am.

Cleanliness: It is the responsibility of each competitor and team to always keep their paddock free of debris.

Paddock Power: Electric is available in the paddock with a cost of \$100 for the two test days. 30, 50, and 110 amp connections are available. Payable via credit card at the gate. Each \$100 power purchase will receive a Tag and zip tie that will go around the end of the power cable that plugs in at the outlet point.

RVs: Overnight camping is allowed in your hauler/tow vehicle in the Paddock at the direction of Trans Am/FRP Staff. Water hookups are limited. No dump station on property. Servicing can be arranged through Mid-Florida Portable Toilets 863-655-2940 . Men's and Women's showers are located throughout the paddock. No overnight camping in the area outside Registration.

Pets: Pets are allowed. They must be always kept on a leash and cleaned up after. No pets allowed inside any buildings or concession areas or on grid or pit lane.

Scooters/Bikes: Stick scooters, hoverboards, single-wheeled powered vehicles, and anything else without a factory-installed seat are prohibited.

Paddock Concessions: The concession stand will not be open during this event.

Waste Disposal: Waste fluid stations are the Safety Kleen huts located in the center of the paddock and at the east end of the paddock.

Golf Cart Rental: No golf carts are available for rent for this event.

Personal Golf Carts: No stickers are required for this event.
