Welcome to FRP's 21st year of operation bringing Racing By Racers - For Racers

We have some structural and procedural changes this year, and this document outlines all you need to know to have a great season racing with FRP.

NEW for 2026, we are changing our racing session format.

- Atlantic 016 & Open classes are now consolidated into a single Atlantic Championship
Eligible Cars and Technical Rules follow the current SCCA GCR section(s) 9.1.1.A
- F1600 & F1600 Masters will remain in its own run group, each with their own podium
- F2000 & Atlantic will run together. When event scheduling permits Race Sessions will be split.
- All FRP RUN GROUPS, we will have the following session format, each contained in a 30 min block: P1, P2, Q, HEAT RACE 1. HEAT RACE 2, CHAMPIONSHIP RACE.

(ALWAYS SUBJECT TO CHANGE HOWEVER AT ANY PARTICULAR VENUE)

Grid for Heat Race 1 (HR1) will be determined by best time from the Qualifying Session.

Grid for Heat Race 2 (HR2) will be determined by best time from HR1

Grid for the Championship Race will be determined by best time from either HR1 or HR2.

- **POINTS** for the Season Championship will be awarded for all three races, weighted to the Championship Race. (See Points & Prize \$ Schedule for each series)
- **PODIUM** (Position 1-3) will only be held for the Championship Race.
- **PRIZE \$** and Contingency Tires will be allocated only for the Championship Race, paying down to 7th place - (minimum entry rules apply).

WAIVERS - (the bedrock of motor racing)

For 2026, Waivers will be signed Online using the Speedwaiver process.

This year it is 2 pages containing both Racing America & FRP waivers, and both pages need to be completed and signed. There is also a MINOR waiver version in the links.

These waivers are in addition to any other track venue waivers one may have to sign.

Drivers with the required FRP 2026 Pro License and Crew/Family/Guests with the optional FRP 2026 Hardcard credential: as part of the ONLINE application process this waiver is signed once as an Annual SpeedWaiver.

Anyone who does not have the FRP License or Crew Hardcard, will be required to sign an online EVENT Specific SpeedWaiver for EACH EVENT.

**ANYONE found at an event without proper credentials & waivers signed
May BE FINED \$500 and/or ejected from the event.**

Drivers of: F1600 - F1600 Masters - F2000 - Atlantic - FE-2

You must have the **2026 FRP PRO License** in order to compete with FRP.

- License application is online through Motorsport Reg. Your MReg Garage Profile must be set up.
- Approval for the FRP Pro License is automatic with a Current Full Competition license issued by SCCA; FIA; HSR; IMSA; NASA; VRG; EMRA; Indy Car; & CACC.
- Other applicants will be reviewed for eligibility by FRP - A racing resume is required for this review.
- The FRP Pro license fee is \$160
- **DRIVER APPLICATION LINK:** msreg.com/FRP-2026-PRO-LICENSE

- **MINOR DRIVERS 14-17 Years of Age** who have not previously been issued a competition license, may be licensed on a case-by-case basis subject to review of a racing resume by FRP.
- **FRP always retains the right to determine qualifications and deny entry of drivers regardless of license held.**

***** Watkins Glen - Special Note - Minor Drivers - under 18 yrs old as of the date of WGI on track activities - must be emancipated in order to participate.**

At Event Registration Procedure

Every Participant entering grounds of a track venue must sign the specific track's waiver, sometimes available online, sometimes only at the gate. Each track will have a specific wrist band for the weekend, which provides you continual weekend access.

EVERY Participant MUST ALSO check in at FRP's Registration **BEFORE** going on track or into the hot pits. This is where we verify eligibility, waivers, payment, and issue the FRP weekend wristband, which **MAY BE** in addition to the track Wristband.

Drivers who do not check in with FRP registration and find their way onto the track **WILL BE** black flagged and may be fined. Anyone found in a hot pit area without proper credentials may be fined (\$500), and this fine will accrue to the associated team.

FRP - Online Event Entry

- Event entry for FRP events is handled through the motorsportreg.com website.
- **Registration Links** are always available on the Hub Page of our website: <http://www.RaceFRP.com> - Or you can search "FRP" on Motorsport Reg.
- Instructions for using the FRP Motorsport Registration are on the registration sites.
- Many drivers already have a profile and "Garage" on motorsportreg.com, and your information will transfer when entering FRP Events. Your Garage is the basis for all event entries and application for the FRP Pro License.
- If you have not yet signed up and added information for your "MotorsportReg Garage" — do so now. - make sure info is correct & complete.

F2000 & Atlantic will run together. When event scheduling permits Race Sessions will be split.

FE-2, CCS and other invited classes will have their own run group(s) at select venues.

Formula Enterprises (FE-2) Eligibility: Per current SCCA GCR sections 9.1.1.G







end plates


