### SCHOLARSHIP DESCRIPTION

Awards are based on several considerations that include academic achievement, community involvement, and need. Scholarships will be awarded in a one time payment by check, within 30 days of announcement.

- Applicant must have a minimum 3.0 GPA.

- The staff and Board of Directors for the SBA will not speak to or communicate with any applicant, or their proxies, regarding their submissions during the application process.
- Applicant finalist must be available for a virtual interview with the scholarship Committee.
