BUDGET STATEMENT:

Pursuant to Section 551.043, Government Code, the following taxpayer impact statement must be on the City Council meeting agenda at which the City Council will discuss or adopt a budget for the City of Perryton with the most recently adopted information: For a median-valued homestead property (\$118,032), the City's portion of the property tax bill in dollars for the current fiscal year (FY 25-26) is \$644.06, the City's portion of the property tax bill for the upcoming fiscal year (FY26-27) for the same property if the proposed budget is adopted is estimated to be \$700.34, and the City's portion of the property tax bill in dollars for the upcoming fiscal year (FY26-27) for the same property if a budget funded at the no-new-revenue rate under Chapter 26, Tax Code, is adopted is estimated to be \$700.34.
