#### We Love Because God Loves Us

# Before Watching: Setting the Stage

- Briefly introduce the theme: Tell your child that the video is about loving others because we are loved.
- Share key ideas in simple words: "God loves us. Because of that, we can love others, too."
- Warm up with a question: "What are some ways we can show love to our family or friends?"

### During the Video: Engage and Observe

- Watch together: Sit close, keep it relaxed, and let them enjoy the visuals and gentle narration.
- Pause when helpful: If the video touches on love, caring, or kindness, pause and point it out: "See how happy that makes them feel?"
- Encourage interaction: Ask, "Do you feel happy when someone is kind to you?"

# After Watching: Connecting Through Discussion

- Ask open-ended questions:
  - "What part did you like best?"
  - "How did the video show that we love because God loves us?"
  - "Can you think of someone you love because they love you?"
- Share practical examples:
  - "When Grandma gives you a hug, that's love. Or when you share your toys, that's loving too!"
- Reinforce the idea: "The video shows that God's love helps us love others. Isn't that beautiful?"

## Reinforcing Love in Everyday Moments

- Gentle reminders: Encourage simple acts—holding hands, sharing snacks, thanking others.
- Storytime extension: Share children's stories or Bible stories about friendship and kindness.
- Creative play: Draw or craft pictures showing people being kind or loving.
- Role modeling: Be the example—let your child see love in action in your interactions with them and others.
