



## Who's in the Story?

- **Samson** - a strong, brave hero with super strength from God.
- **Delilah** - a curious friend who asks Samson about his secret.
- **Philistines** - the people who don't like Samson and want to know why he's so strong.

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## What Happens?

1. **Meet Samson** - he's really strong because of his long hair (a special gift from God).
2. **Along comes Delilah** - she's interested in Samson and asks him questions about his strength.
3. **Secret revealed!** - Samson tells Delilah his secret.
4. **Why?** - spoiler: Delilah tells the Philistines, and trouble begins.
5. **Big lesson** - Sharing secrets with someone you don't really know can cause problems.

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## Talk About It

Use fun, simple questions to engage your child:

- "Would you want super strength like Samson?"
  - "What would you do if you were really strong?"
  - "Do you think Samson should have shared his hair-secret?"
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## Activity Time!

Make it creative:

- **Draw** Samson with his strong muscles and super hair.
  - **Build** your own "hair-secret" box using a small shoe box. Talk about keeping special things safe.
  - **Role-play** as Samson and Delilah with some puppets or stuffed toys. Practice telling the difference between good sharing and secrets.
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## Simple Lesson

- **People we don't know well aren't who we share secrets with.**
  - **Trust grows over time.** It's okay to tell secrets only when you really trust someone.
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## A Little Prayer (if you'd like!)

"Dear God, thank You for keeping us safe and strong. Help us to choose good friends and know when it's okay to share secrets. Amen."
