Parent Guide: Helping Your Preschooler Understand "Peter's Vision"

What the Video is About



The video tells the Bible story of **Peter** seeing a special vision from God. In this vision, God shows him that **all people are loved and welcomed by God**, no matter where they come from. It's a lesson about kindness, accepting others, and sharing God's love.

Main Message for Preschoolers

- God loves everyone.
- We can be friends with people who are different from us.
- Everyone is special to God.

Talking Points During or After the Video

☑ Point out the vision scene:

Say: "God showed Peter that every person is important. Do you think everyone is special to God?"

▼ Talk about friends and kindness:

Say: "Have you met friends who are different from you? We can still be kind and love them, right?"

☑ Use simple language:

Say: "God doesn't have favorite people. He loves all of us!"

Simple Activity Suggestions

"Everyone is Special" Craft:

Give your child crayons and paper, and have them draw themselves and friends. Talk about how God loves every person in their picture.

"Welcome Game:"

Play a pretend game where you and your child practice welcoming friends with a smile, a wave, or a hug.

🛢 Read Together:

If you have a children's Bible, read the story from Acts 10 together and point to the illustrations.

👋 Reassure and Encourage

At the end, tell your preschooler:

- "God loves you very much."
- "God loves all people, no matter where they live or what they look like."
- "We can show God's love by being kind to everyone."
