

This animated retelling of Jonah's journey—being called by God, trying to run away, being swallowed by a big fish, praying on the inside, and finally sharing God's message—makes a classic Bible story fun and easy for little ones to follow.

Recommended Viewing Tips

1. Preparation

Explain that this is an old Bible story with a talking fish. Let them know it's make-believe, but has important lessons.

2. Watch Together

Preschoolers may need guidance. Ask gentle questions like, "Why do you think Jonah got swallowed?" to keep them engaged.

3. Pause & Chat

 Before the whale appears: "How do you think Jonah felt when he didn't listen?"

- During the big fish scene: "That fish is huge! How do you think Jonah is feeling inside?"
- o After Jonah prays and is let out: "Why was he grateful?"

Key Lessons for Little Ones

- Listening is important: Jonah didn't listen at first, and it led to trouble.
- Say sorry and ask for help: Jonah prayed when he felt scared and sorry.
- Everyone can learn and change: Even Jonah changed his mind and did the right thing.

Conversation Starters

- "Have you ever done something you knew wasn't right, like Jonah?"
- "What helps you feel better if you're scared or feel sorry?"
- "What would you do if you got a second chance?"

Timing & Attention Span

The video runs around 5-6 minutes—perfect for preschool attention spans! If they lose focus, feel free to pause and revisit a scene or two.
