Materials Needed

- Crayons, colored pencils, or markers
- Scissors
- Glue or tape (optional, if mounting on construction paper)
- A brass fastener is optional if you want to turn it into a spinner

Instructions

1. Read or listen to the story of Paul in Acts 21:17-19, 21:27-40, and 22:1-16.
2. Turn to page 2 and look at the wheel. The wheel is divided into 3 parts.
3. In the section labeled "Before Paul Met Jesus," draw or write what Paul was like before he followed Jesus.
4. In the section labeled "How Paul Met Jesus," draw or write what happened when Jesus spoke to Paul on the road.
5. In the section labeled "After Paul Met Jesus," draw or write how Paul's life changed and how he told others about Jesus.
6. Color the wheel.
7. If you want, carefully cut out the wheel and glue it onto construction paper, or use a brass fastener to make it into a spinner craft.

Helpful Ideas

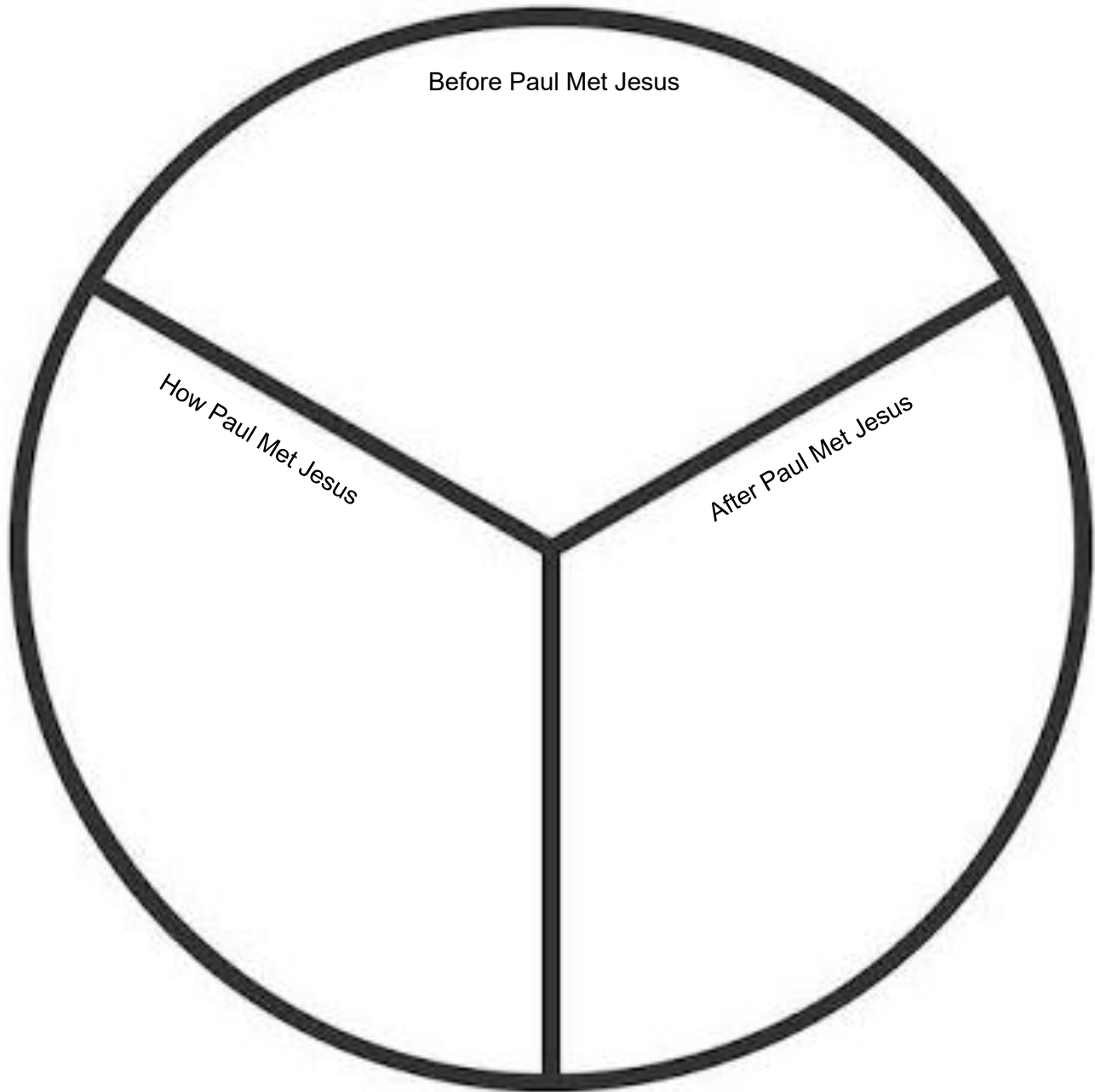
Before Paul Met Jesus: He did not follow Jesus and was against Christians. How Paul Met Jesus: Jesus spoke to him, and Paul listened. After Paul Met Jesus: Paul believed in Jesus, was baptized, and told others about Him.

Paul used his story to tell others what Jesus had done in his life.
