NOW LET'S LIVE IT!

This month in FC Kids, we learned what it means to stay locked in as we build a secure faith in Jesus. We discovered that because Jesus never changes, our faith in Him can stay steady and secure.

Here are some simple ways to help your family live out this truth together:

TRUST IN GOD'S GOODNESS!

We learned how Jesus healed ten men with leprosy—showing kindness and goodness when they needed it. As a family, talk about times when things feel hard or confusing, and remind each other that God is still good, even when you don't understand everything. Take time to thank God for the good things you see—big or small—and practice staying locked in to His goodness together.

BELIEVE IN GOD'S POWER!

We saw how God shows His power when Dorcas was healed—reminding us that nothing is too difficult for Him. As a family, share the things you need God's help with and pray together, trusting that God is strong and able. As you remember God's power, choose to rest in the truth that your family is safe and secure in Him.

CHOOSE TO TRUST GOD!

Remember how David trusted God when he faced Goliath, even though the challenge looked huge and scary? As a family, talk about situations in your own lives that feel big right now, and discuss what it looks like to trust God and obey Him, even when it feels hard. Choose one brave step of trust to take this week...showing honesty, kindness, or courage.

REMEMBER GOD IS WITH US!

Look up Ephesians 6:10-20 and read about the Armor Of God. Talk together as a family about each one and how God protects you, strengthens you, and is with you each day!

Share moments when someone feels lonely, afraid, or unsure, and remind each other that God is always with you. Then choose one way to show kindness or encouragement to someone else this week, reflecting the security you have in Jesus.
