




Football is a Game of Skill

- What are the first things you have to learn to become a good student?
- How much time and effort does it take to get good at maths? at reading? at science?
- What would you do if you weren't good right away?

How to become great at any game of skill:

- 1. Get the whole story up front—what does 'winning' or success look like?
- 2. Learn the moves—the small skills you need to play the game.
- 3. Practice the moves in combination to learn how and when to use them.
- 4. Play the game a lot!
