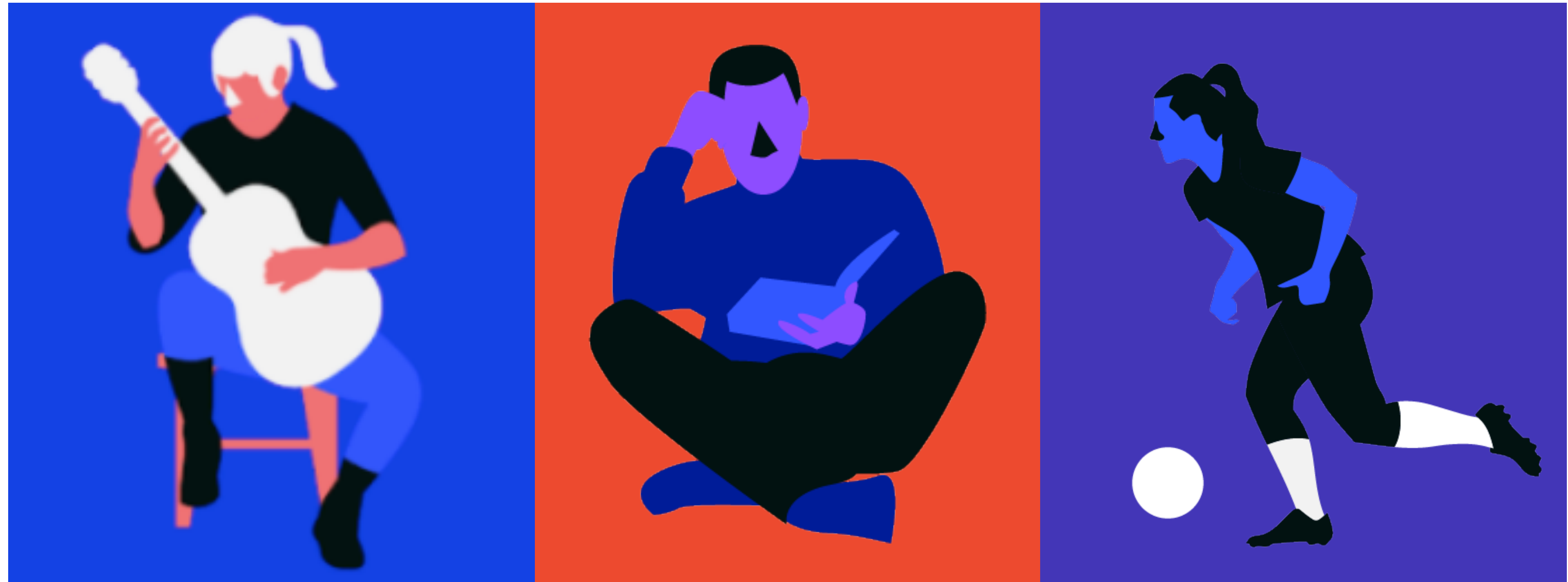


Learning is a **Game of Skill**

Every Subject is a Game of Skill

- What are the first things you have to learn to become a good student?
- How much time and effort does it take to get good at maths? at reading? at science?
- What would you do if you weren't good right away?

How to become great at **any** game of skill:

1. **Get the whole story up front**—what does ‘winning’ or success look like?
2. **Learn the moves**—the small skills you need to play the game.
3. **Practice the moves in combination** to learn how and when to use them.
4. **Play the game a lot!**
