VETERANS GOLF

Although most of the rain has departed, and only the back 8 holes were open as I write, I have been informed by a high authority (who shall remain nameless) that Luke at Royal North is hopeful that the whole course will be open for play on Friday, albeit without the use of carts. Let's all cross our fingers, and watch out for a positive update from Captain Matt.

Under our revised Vets Golf program, there will be no Monthly Medal event for August - our first "miss" since October 2022 – but if we play this week, it will be the President's Team v the Captain's Team, an annual individual Stableford event. The rules for the game can be described as follows: Players from each team will be selected to compete head-to-head (generally both being in the same grade), the player with the highest Stableford score on each hole winning that hole. If equal scores, the hole is squared. The player with the highest number of holes won after 18 holes is the winner of their match. Countback rules will be applied if both players win the same number of holes. At the end of the day the number of winners in each team is tallied, the winning team being the one having the most winners. Each member of the winning team will receive a ball. Longest Drives and Nearest the Pins apply as usual. A number of us are probably very rusty after not playing for several weeks, but may the best team win!

A few further statistics for the year, gleaned from Mal Cross' Mr Consistency spreadsheet, are about the only updates I can provide, given the absence of games placed since 25th July.

- Chris Tomkins has won the most games (6), followed by John Mongan and Brian Reeves, both with 4 wins. Apart from his 4 wins, Brian has not featured among our placegetters.
- Joe Oliver has had the most placings (10), followed by Kevin Doherty and Joe Scardino, who have each been placed 9 times.
- Les Bassett, Jim Campbell, Tony Galligan and Brian Reeves have each reached their maximum 8 LDs, with Ian Miller and Chris Tomkins one away, with 7 LDs.
- Only Mark Bennett and Kevin Doherty have reached their maximum NTPs, with Robert Chung-Gon and Mal Cross one away from getting there.
- Joe Scardino has played the most successive games (18), followed by David Williams (16) and Dennis Chiddy (14). David would have competed in all of our 25 games, except for missing our May Monthly Medal game, and the only game Joe Oliver missed playing was the individual Stableford on 14th March.



And with this year's event less than a month away – it starts on 26th September - here are a few Ryder Cup-related Trivia questions:

1. What is the largest winning margin in any 18-hole match, which players were involved, and in which year did it occur?
2. In which year did a team from Europe first compete against the United States?
3. Of Tiger Woods' 8 Ryder Cup appearances, how many did the United States win, and how many of Tiger's 37 matches did he win?
4. Which golfer has played in the most Ryder Cup tournaments?
5. How many Ryder Cups has the United States won this century?
6. Who was the last playing captain in the Ryder Cup for (a) the United States and (b) Europe?
