VETERANS GOLF

As I write this, the sun is shining, and all 18 holes at Royal North are open again, for the first time in over a month. From a review of Elite Golf's website, it also appears that carts will most likely be permitted for our return to golf this Friday, but this will be confirmed by Vice-Captain Brian closer to the event.

This Friday we'll be playing our September Monthly Medal (MM) & Putting Competition game which will be followed, at the course, by our monthly barbecue, to which all playing and non-playing members are invited. If you're playing this Friday, please try to stay after the game to enjoy not only the great barbecue fare, but the company of your golfing mates. If you're a non-playing member or ex-member, you're always welcome to join us after the game.

This round will also constitute the delayed 2nd round of our Grade Championships. Because we were unable to play 2nd round of our Grade Championships last month, the 3rd and 4th rounds of the Grade

Championships have also been pushed back a month, and will be played in conjunction with October's and November's MM games. The handicaps our members use for each MM are those calculated by our Handicapper after your most recent game, prior to the MM. The handicaps for each Grade Championship round are those used for your first Grade Championship round, i.e. you'll have the same handicap for each round. (We try to keep our Handicapper, Mal Cross, as busy as possible.)

Next week we'll be playing the delayed President's Team v Captain's Team challenge, which is played in a Stableford format. Players in the President's Team will go head-to-head against players in the Captain's Team - usually of the same grade - with the winners of each match being the player with the most holes won in the match. Where the match is squared (i.e. each player has won the same number of holes) the player last in front wins the match. The winning team is the one with the most winners of the individual head-to-head matches.



And here are the answers to last week's Ryder Cup-related Trivia questions:

1. The largest winning margin in any 18-hole match, was the 9 & 7 win by Victor Hovland and Ludvig Aberg over Scottie Scheffler and Brooks Koepka in an 18-hole foursome match in 2023.
2. A team from Europe first competed against the United States in 1979.
3. Of Tiger Woods' 8 Ryder Cup appearances, the United States only won 1 (in 1999), and of the 37 matches Tiger played he only won 13.
4. Phil Mickelson has played in the most Ryder Cup tournaments (12 appearances).
5. The United States team has only won 3 Ryder Cups this century (2008, 2016 and 2021; Europe has won 8 times over the same period).
6. (a) Arnold Palmer was the last playing US Team captain in the Ryder Cup (1963) and (b) the Europe Team hasn't had a playing captain (Dai Rees was the last playing captain for the Great Britain and Ireland team, in 1961)
