The Monthly Medal (MM) was won by Tony Marando (hcp 30) on count-back (c/b) from Roy Mercer (hcp 32). Tony and Roy both had the same stroke score on the back 9, so the c/b winner was determined by the least strokes over the last 6 holes. Congratulations on your win, Tony! Tony last won the MM in September 2023, sharing it with Bruce Miller. March must be a Marando MM month, because cousin Sam won in in March last year. As a result of his net 63, Roy will be back in B-Grade for this week's game. Speaking of B-Grade, the upper limit for the grade will be extended to handicap 32 from this week's game, in order to balance up the numbers in each grade.

LDs and NTPs for the year.


And thanks, once again, to our barbecue team,

This week's game will feature an Individual
Stableford, which will incorporate the 3rd round
of the Cock-Of-The-Walk (COW). Good luck to
all players, and it will be very interesting to see
whom of our 4 A-Graders, 1 B-Grader and 4 C-
Graders will progress to the COW semi-finals.

And a reminder that our first away game for 2026, organised by Bruce Miller, is due to be played at Moore Park next Monday. Hopefully the weather will be kind, the fairways will have plenty of run, and the greens will be easy to read for all of our 20 confirmed starters. As previously mentioned, players requiring carts will need to pay at the Pro shop, on the day.

And the answers to last week's Masters-related question are:

- 1: Gary Player holds the record for most starts in the Masters, with 52, between 1957 and 2009 (he missed starting, due to illness, in 1973, the year when Jack Nicklaus's 8 consecutive birdies in his last-round 66, enabled him to tie for 3rd with Jim Jamieson and Peter Oosterhuis, 2 shots behind the winner, Tommy Aaron).
- 2: Arnold Palmer holds the record for most consecutive starts in the Masters, with 50, from 1955-2004 inclusive (Palmer's 4 wins occurred at two-yearly intervals, between 1958 and 1964, and his highest placing after finishing 4th in 1967, was 11th in 1974).
- 3: Last year's winner, Rory McIlroy, is the only Masters winner to have 4 double bogeys in his winning 4 rounds.
