One of our 3-man group remarked upon how well the course presented, and that it was probably the best value for a public course in Sydney. A lot of TLC has gone into Royal North, and it's a credit to the greenkeepers for their efforts.

In relation to our new members, Joe Vescio, in his second game, won an A-Grade Nearest The Pin, and David Rigby, in his first game, teamed with his mate George Paul, to finish 3rd in the Ambrose. Both Joe and David are on provisional handicaps, but based on the form that David showed last week - he's certainly not a C-Grader - our Handicapper has used his discretion, and elevated David to B-Grade this week. We hope that both Joe and David continue to enjoy playing with our Vets group.

The team of Noel Halliwell and Joe Scardino finished with a net 62.25, off a 13.75 handicap, winning narrowly from the team of Don Bayly and Roy Mercer – net 62.75 (H13.25). The team of George Paul and David Rigby finished 3rd, with a net 64.00, albeit off a very generous handicap of 18. 10 of the groups finished at net par (68) or better. Unfortunately for the 3-man team, whose combined handicap was divided by 10, for a net 8.9, they couldn't buy a putt, and finished towards the rear of the field. Mark Bennett, one of the group of 3, had hoped that he could replicate his previous week's performance, but alas, it was not to be. Noel and Joe, both long hitters (Noel incredibly so), combined for a team birdie on long Par 5 9th hole. A number of teams made it difficult for the results to be correctly calculated, because they recorded their scores, as markers, in the columns marked "Player" on the scorecards. To make it easier on those tabulating the results, please remember that the scores recorded for "Player(s)" on the scorecard should be those of the Player(s) whose names appear on the scorecard, and that Players and their Markers should sign the scorecards as such (this wasn't done for some cards last week).
