Saint Padre Pio of Pietrelcina

The feast day of St. Pius of Pietrelcina, also known as Padre Pio, is celebrated on **September 23rd**. Padre Pio was an Italian Capuchin friar, priest, mystic, and stigmatic who lived from 1887 to

1968 and is widely venerated for his deep spirituality and supernatural gifts. He lived the Rosary, encouraging people to “pray, hope, and don’t worry.” He united his suffering with Christ’s Passion. He cared deeply for the sick and the poor.

Prayer to St. Padre Pio: “St. Pio of Pietrelcina, faithful servant of Christ, you bore the wounds of Jesus and carried the cross with love. Intercede for us, that we may be strengthened in prayer, faithful in suffering, and generous in charity. Amen.”



Holy Archangels, September 29.

The Feast of the Archangels is celebrated in the Church on September 29 each year. It honors the three archangels

named in Sacred Scripture: **St. Michael the Archangel** – defender of the Church, protector against evil, and leader of the heavenly armies. **St. Gabriel the Archangel** – God’s messenger, who announced the Good News of the Incarnation to the Blessed Virgin Mary. **St. Raphael the Archangel** – companion and healer, known from the Book of Tobit as the guide and protector of Tobias. The feast reminds us of the constant presence of the angels in our lives and their mission as God’s messengers and protectors. St. Michael teaches us courage in spiritual battles. St. Gabriel inspires us to listen to God’s Word and respond with faith. St. Raphael shows God’s healing and guiding care in our journey. **The feast day Mass will be on Monday, September 29 at 9 am.**

National Day for Truth and Reconciliation.

September 30th is the National Day for Truth and Reconciliation, which coincides with Orange Shirt Day. This day honors the children who never returned home, as well as the Survivors of residential schools and their families and communities. As a church community, we

will reflect on the tragic and painful history and the ongoing impacts of residential schools. This also serves as a time for us to recommit to the reconciliation process. We invite everyone to join us in solidarity with all Indigenous peoples of this land by wearing an orange shirt during the weekend of September 28th as you attend Mass.

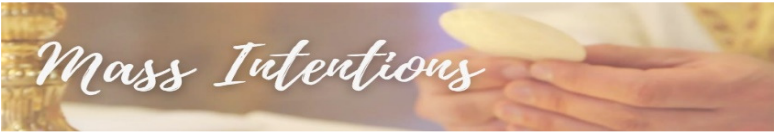
The Search Begins on October 9th.
