The time has come to celebrate a truly special milestone, the 60th Anniversary of our Parish! This joyful occasion invites us to pause in gratitude for all that has been, to

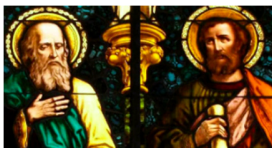

World Mission Sunday.

October 19 marks the 99th World Mission Day. In a video message, Pope Leo XIV highlights this day as a time for the whole Church to unite in prayer for missionaries and the fruitfulness of their work. Recalling his missionary years in Peru, he shared how faith, prayer, and generosity on World Mission Sunday can transform communities. Echoing this year’s theme, *“Missionaries of Hope among All Peoples,”* the Holy Father urges us to renew our commitment to bring Christ, our Hope, to the ends of the earth.

A second collection for World Mission Sunday will be taken in our parish on the weekend of October 26.



St. Simon & St. Jude

Simon and Jude are named among the Apostles in the New Testament, though little is known about them. Since there are two apostles named Simon and two named Judas (Lk.6.14-16 and Acts 1.13),

these are distinguished as Simon the Zealot and Judas the son (or the brother) of James, the others being Simon Peter and Judas Iscariot. Traditionally, both these apostles suffered martyrdom. In a later tradition, St. Jude became a patron saint of so-called hopeless causes. Their feast is celebrated on October 28.

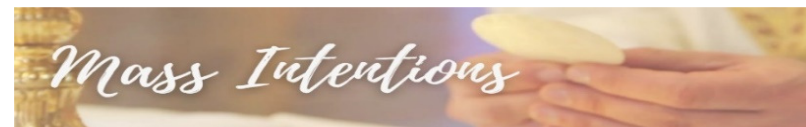
All Saints Youth Night
