# THE PRESENTATION OF MARY, November 21.

This feast began as a commemoration of the dedication of the Church of the Mother of God in Jerusalem, a Byzantine church. Originally celebrated in the East, it spread to the West in the 11th century

and became a universal feast in the 16th century.

According to the *Protoevangelium of James*, Anna and Joachim offered Mary to God in the Temple at the age of three, fulfilling a promise made when Anna was childless. The feast reminds us that from the very beginning, Mary was wholly dedicated to God—becoming a living temple where God marvellously chose to dwell and through whom His saving work was revealed.



# **SOLEMNITY OF CHRIST THE KING**

The Church celebrates the Feast of Christ the King, also called the Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe, on the last Sunday of the Liturgical year. The

Feast was established by Pope Pius XI in 1925 with his encyclical *Quas Primas*, to respond to a world that was rejecting Christ. This feast powerfully declares Christ's Kingship over individuals, families, society and nations. Christ the King is one of the most important titles of Jesus. Jesus Christ is the Divine King of the Universe, who unites all of creation with the Heavenly Father, *Ref.* (1Corinthians 15:25-28). This feast will be celebrated on the weekend of Nov. 23, this year.
