THIRD ADVENT CANDLE

This weekend, December 14, we light the third Advent candle—the Candle of Joy, also known as the Shepherd's Candle. This Sunday is called Gaudete Sunday, from the Latin gaudete, meaning "rejoice." The Rose

candle on the Advent wreath reminds us of this joyful pause in our Advent journey. The Entrance Antiphon echoes St. Paul's words: "Rejoice in the Lord always; again, I say, rejoice. Indeed, the Lord is near" (Philippians 4:4–5). The shepherds, too, received this message of joy and responded with faith: "Let us go to Bethlehem and see this thing that has happened, which the Lord has made known to us" (Luke 2:15).



FOURTH ADVENT CANDLE

On the Fourth Sunday of Advent, we light the fourth candle—the Candle of Love, also known as the Angel Candle. The angels proclaimed the Good News: "I bring you good news of great joy for all the people. Today, in the town of David, a Savior has been born to you; he is the

Messiah, the Lord" (Luke 2:10–11). God sent his only Son to save us because he loves us: "For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son... not to condemn the world, but to save the world through him" (John 3:16–17).

The Gift That Matters Most This Christmas

What if the most important thing you do this Christmas isn't what you buy or bake, but who you invite? Many people around us carry heavy burdens—grief, uncertainty, or loneliness—and may feel distant from church or unsure they belong. Yet the message of the first Christmas still rings true: "Do not be afraid. I bring you good news of great joy for all the people" (Luke 2:10).

This season is a wonderful opportunity to invite someone to experience God's love in a place that truly feels like home. Your invitation could be the greatest gift they receive—opening the door to hope and joy in Jesus our Lord. We look forward to welcoming you and your loved ones home for Christmas.
