St. Thomas Aquinas, endowed with one of the greatest intellects in the history of the Church, was not only a philosopher and theologian, but a humble seeker of God. A Doctor of the Church and patron of Catholic universities, colleges, and schools, he reminds us that true wisdom is born of faith. Under the guidance of St. Albert the Great, he helped shape the scholastic method that served the Church for centuries, yet his heart remained rooted in prayer and contemplation. As he himself wisely observed, *“To one who has faith, no explanation is necessary; to one without faith, no explanation is possible.”* May St. Thomas Aquinas intercede for us, that our pursuit of knowledge may always lead us closer to God.




**St. John Bosco January 31**  
St. John Bosco was moved by the plight of poor, orphaned, and troubled young people in Turin, Italy. He dedicated his life to offering them love, discipline, education, friendship, and a sense of family. Through his gentle humility and deep concern, he led many young people to Christ, including St. Dominic Savio.  
St. John Bosco believed that Christ’s love and our faith in it should permeate every aspect of life, work, study, and play. He promoted "frequent Confession, frequent Communion and daily Mass" as fundamental to spiritual well-being.

**Presentation of the Lord**  
This feast is celebrated on February 2 throughout the universal Church. The Gospel of Luke (2:22–40) recounts how Mary and Joseph brought the forty-day-old Jesus to the Temple in Jerusalem to present Him to God, in faithful obedience to Jewish law. This event is also remembered as the Fourth Joyful Mystery of the Rosary. This Gospel scene reveals the mystery of the Son of the Virgin—the One consecrated to the Father—who came into the world to carry out His Father’s will with perfect fidelity (cf. Heb 10:5–7). Simeon recognizes the Child as “a light for revelation to the Gentiles” (Lk 2:32) and, through prophetic words, foretells His supreme offering to God and His ultimate victory (cf. Lk 2:32–35).  
This moment marks the meeting point of the Old and New Testaments. Jesus enters the ancient Temple—He who is Himself the new Temple of God. In visiting His people, He fulfills the Law and ushers in the fullness of salvation.
