The Mass for Neophytes

The Mass for Neophytes is a special liturgy celebrating adults who were newly baptized or fully initiated into the Church. The word *neophyte* means "newly planted," referring to those who have recently begun their life of faith. This Mass is celebrated during the Easter season to welcome and encourage the newly initiated as they continue their journey of faith. It also marks the conclusion of the period called *mystagogy*, when the new members reflect more deeply on the sacraments they received at the Easter Vigil.

This celebration highlights the moment when candidates enter into full communion with the Church and reminds the community of the importance of supporting them in their new life of faith. It also encourages the neophytes to take an active role in the life of the Church, especially in the celebration of the Eucharist.

Archbishop Lepine invites every community in the Archdiocese to celebrate a special Mass of Thanksgiving for these new members on Sunday April 19. Our parish will celebrate the Neophyte Mass on **April 19 at the 10:30 a.m. Mass**. We warmly invite everyone in our community to participate, welcome the new members of our parish family, and pray that they remain faithful to their baptismal promises and continue to grow in their faith.

THE LORD'S DAY

Discovering the beauty of the Catholic Church through the Catechism of the Church. (CCC1166-1167)

"By a tradition handed down from the apostles which took its origin from the very day of Christ's Resurrection, the Church celebrates the Paschal mystery every seventh day, which day is appropriately called the Lord's Day or Sunday."³⁶ The day of Christ's Resurrection is both the first day of the week, the memorial of the first day of creation, and the "eighth day," on which Christ after his "rest" on the great sabbath inaugurates the "day that the Lord has made," the "day that knows no evening."³⁷ The Lord's Supper is its center, for there the whole community of the faithful encounters the risen Lord who invites them to his banquet:³⁸

The Lord's Day, the day of Resurrection, the day of Christians, is our day. It is called the Lord's Day because on it the Lord rose victorious to the Father. If pagans call it the "day of the sun," we willingly agree, for today the light of the world is raised, today is revealed the sun of justice with healing in his rays.³⁹

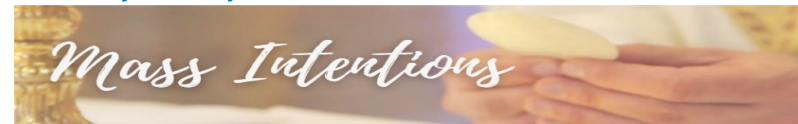
Sunday is the pre-eminent day for the liturgical assembly, when the faithful gather "to listen to the word of God and take part in the Eucharist, thus calling to mind the Passion, Resurrection, and glory of the Lord Jesus, and giving thanks to God who 'has begotten them again, by the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead' unto a living hope":⁴⁰

When we ponder, O Christ, the marvels accomplished on this day, the Sunday of your holy resurrection, we say: "Blessed is Sunday, for on it began creation ... the world's salvation ... the renewal of the human race. ... On Sunday heaven and earth rejoiced and the whole universe was filled with light. Blessed is Sunday, for on it were opened the gates of paradise so that Adam and all the exiles might enter it without fear."⁴¹ (CCC #1166-1167)
