"Every family needs a father — a father who shares in his family's joy and pain, hands down wisdom to his children and offers them firm guidance and love." - Pope Francis



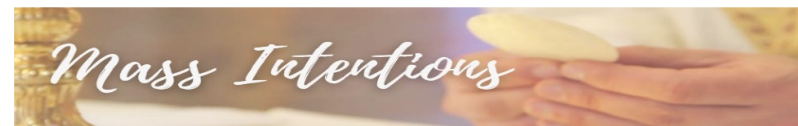
Nativity of St. John the Baptist, June 24

St. John the Baptist is a major figure in the history of salvation. While in his mother's womb, he recognized the Saviour, his birth was accompanied by great signs; he retired to the desert where he led a life of austerity and penance. Devotion to St. John the Baptist has been present in the Christian Church since ancient times. In addition to the celebration of his death (29 August), of all the Saints he is the only one (besides Jesus and Mary) whose birth is also celebrated. He is the patron saint of those condemned to death or who have been imprisoned for the witness to the faith.
