Morning - Co-Design actions

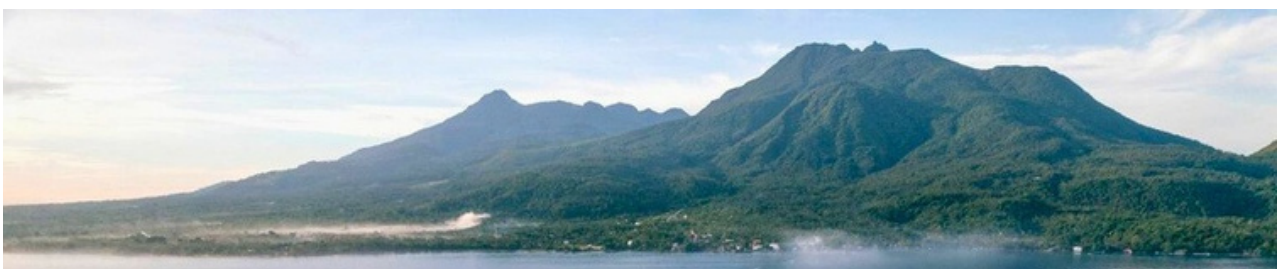
Ideation and design of actions in groups or as individuals for your place & projects. Possibility to join a group designing next steps for Camiguin Island.

HOW TO GET TO CAMIGUIN

For International Travelers

You can book your flight to either Cebu International Airport or Manila Ninoy Aquino International Airport. Once in the Philippines you can book a flight to Camiguin Island through Cebu Pacific Airlines. There are flights going to Camiguin Island coming from Cebu to Manila.

Once you arrive on Camiguin Island we can arrange your pick up from the airport.

Visa Information: Please check whether you are a passport holder from a country that does not need a visa to enter the Philippines

For Travelers in the Philippines

You can reach Camiguin Island by plane from Manila and Cebu with Cebu Pacific Airlines. You can also reach Camiguin Island by boat if you are coming from Bohol. If you are coming from Mindanao you can reach Camiguin Island by land transportation and boat. If you are coming from Mindanao and wish to commute from CDO you can reserve a seat in a van which will take you from Cagayan de Oro all the way to your accommodation on Camiguin Island.

Give yourself a buffer for changes in travel plans

Traveling in the Philippines is an adventure. Changes can happen for many reasons. From weather conditions, transport problems or other factors. If you have the luxury of time, we recommend to come one day early before the start of the (un)Summit. And if you are leaving the island to catch an international flight, it is best to give yourself at least a 12 - 24 hour buffer to catch your international flight.
