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Prohibited
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SEC. 9-4-1 DISTURBANCE OF THE PEACE WITH MOTOR VEHICLE

No driver of any vehicle, including motorcycles, all-terrain vehicles, utility terrain vehicles, and bicycles, shall cause, by excessive and unnecessary acceleration, the tires of such vehicle to spin and emit loud noises or to throw stones or gravel; nor shall such driver operate his vehicle in a manner known as "spinning doughnuts," wherein a vehicle is driven rapidly in a right radius, or in a manner known as "fishtailing," wherein the vehicle is driven in such a manner as to cause the rear of the vehicle to unnecessarily sway from side to side; nor at such speeds or in such a manner that could endanger property or the safety of another person or property.

SEC. 9-4-2 PEDESTRIAN REGULATIONS

(a) Pedestrian Obedience to Traffic Control Devices and Regulations.

- (1) Obedience to Traffic Control Devices. No person shall fail to obey the instructions of any Uniform Traffic Control Device when traveling as a pedestrian on any highway within the City of Thorp unless otherwise directed by a law enforcement officer.
- (2) Crossing at Crosswalks. Pedestrians shall cross a public highway or street at a crosswalk whenever practicable. Where sidewalks are provided, no pedestrian shall walk along and upon an adjacent roadway except when the sidewalk is visibly unsafe, obstructed or closed to public travel.

SEC. 9-4-7**STREET BARRICADES**

No person, without lawful authority, shall move, alter, reposition, take down, damage, destroy or remove any barrier or barricade erected under sections 86.06, 349.02 or 349.10 Wis. Stats.
