

Dunn Center City Council Special Meeting Thursday July 31st, 2025. Vice President Shasta Blackford called the meeting to order at 6 PM. The members present were VP Shasta Blackford, Colton Medley and Daniel Binek. Also present was Chantel Morris and Shaun Lambert.

New Business:

Shasta Blackford removed agenda item C.) Ordinance Amendments due to Joel Quanbeck not being able to make meeting at this time.

The council decided to appoint the Mayor for Dunn Center rather than holding a special election, leaving an available seat on council. VP Shasta Blackford informs that the mayoral position term will end in the year 2028. If council were to appoint Jeremiah Ewer or Daniel Binek as Mayor then their council position will need to be filled till 2028, and if Colton Medley or Shasta Blackford were to be appointed as Mayor their council position will need to be filled till 2026. VP Shasta Blackford was under the impression that the cities Rest and Meal Period Policy needed to be adjusted for employees.
