JOB TITLE: University Ministry Intern

REPORTS TO: Director of University Ministry

POSITION RATIONAL: To create opportunities for students to know life in Jesus through building relationships and creating experiences for the purpose of sharing the Gospel and making disciples.

SALARY: \$2,750 per month for 10 months at 29 hours per week

Dates of the position: Aug 3, 2026 to May 4, 2027

This position is overtime eligible.

BENEFITS: Paid Sick Leave, available as it is earned
Paid Vacation as approved by their supervisor
Paid Holidays over the 10 months

REQUIREMENTS:

- Grounded in Christian faith
- Desire to lead church activities
- Servant's heart
- Able to minister to college aged adults and has a desire to help them begin, continue and improve their walk with Christ
- Good communications skills—oral and written
- Comfortable speaking to small and large groups
- Good administrative and organizational skills

- Good team player, able to build good working relationships with other ministries in the church

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Building Relationships

An essential role of UMin interns is connecting relationally with students. In many ways, the interns are the social gatekeepers of the Annex, defining the relational culture of the community. Staying open, aware and loving of students in your vicinity is important. Relationship building happens in two main ways:

- One on One: Many ways to spend the time but what is essential is the face to face interaction with the intention of loving through listening, encouraging and praying for the student. Each week interns are expected to initiate 7 to 9 one-on-ones with students.
 - 2–3 regulars (weekly)
 - 2–3 semi regulars (bi-weekly / monthly)
 - 2–3 new people
 - Check in or meet with assigned Student Leader once per semester
 - Record on our shared Google doc the students that you met with at the end of each week to get an accurate account of who we are investing in and who we've missed
