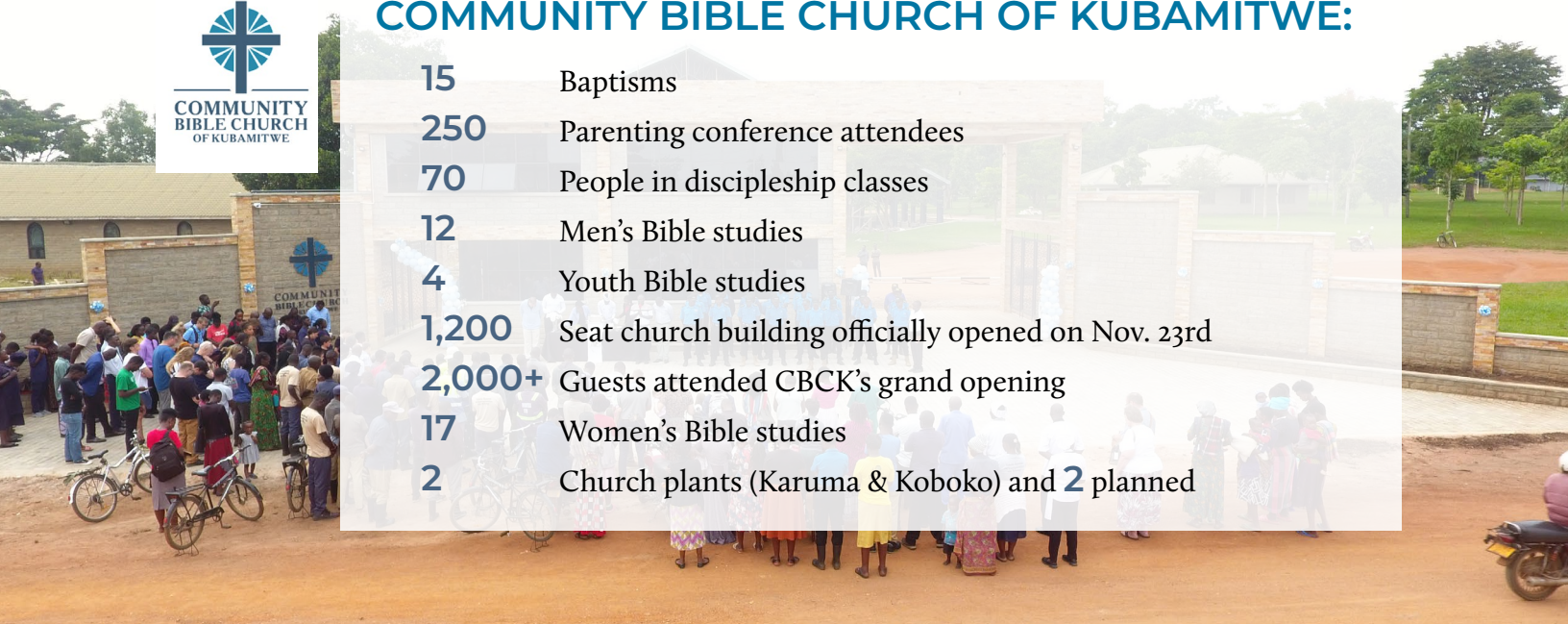
As you read the highlights from this year's report, we pray you are reminded that every testimony of impact is shared fruit—yours and ours together, for the glory of God.
