## General Faculty Registration

**All presenters are required to register online.** Since the Professional Development Committee (PDC) convenes quarterly to adjust the events schedule according to members' continuing education needs, a response to your application to present may not be provided for up to 90 days. The PDC and GA | SC Institutes on Aging staff reserve the right of approval based on LeadingAge Georgia & LeadingAge South Carolina membership survey results regarding issue and topic areas. In addition, please be sure to keep a copy of your request.

## Annual Conference Faculty Registration

If selected, all presenters are required to register for the conference. Presenter registration fees are waived for the day in which you present (Note: this does not include entry into the solutions center expo hall & foyer unless registered as an exhibitor/sponsor). However, registration fees apply if you wish to attend the full conference or a day(s) outside of your presentation date. Actual registration fees will vary depending upon your membership type, when you register, and the number of days you attend the conference beyond your presentation date. Also, LeadingAge GA/SC and the GA/SC Institutes cannot pay travel, per diem or other costs for presenters unless previously negotiated.

Since we wish to provide a forum for presentations not only by experienced professionals, but also by national experts in the field, we require a detailed abstract of the proposed sessions (to include goals and objectives) as well as information on background and experience (Bio/Resume/CV).

- Special attention will be given to proposals that relate to the conference theme or events from surveys and evaluations.
- In addition, proposals which reflect correct/current language promoted in our field are given preference (i.e., Field of aging vs. industry; Resident vs. Patient; Community vs. Facility; etc.) For more information contact [sbassett@leadingagega.org](mailto:sbassett@leadingagega.org)
- More than one application may be submitted by an individual in any of the formats; however, priority will be given to allowing opportunities for more individuals to present.
- It is important to indicate accurately the level of prior knowledge assumed for session attendees. We encourage more presentations of an advanced level, as well as some that cover the basics.
- Use of handouts, slide presentations, demonstrations and audience involvement is highly encouraged and must be provided days in advance for CEU validation purposes.
- Reading of papers and/or PowerPoints is discouraged. However, LeadingAge GA/SC business members are granted opportunities to submit articles in the Association's monthly newsletter.
- Session organizers are encouraged to include presenters from around the country. Sessions involving multiple presenters from different organizations within the southeast region will be given preference due to fiscal restraints.
- In order to assure the highest quality educational program and the greatest breadth of issues covered, staff reserves the right to combine sessions or group a number of presentations in a single time period.
