The building includes 32 residential units, bike hub, and pet-friendly amenities, contributing to steady foot traffic and a vibrant community base. The 1,392 SF commercial space features excellent street frontage along Minnehaha Avenue and a small southern facing patio, creating the perfect setting for a neighborhood café, boutique retailer, wellness studio, or service provider committed to sustainability and community connection.

Nestled in the Howe neighborhood, part of the Longfellow community and neighboring Hiawatha, The Argo places your business in a connected, bike and transit-friendly setting along Minnehaha Avenue. 








Site Plan
