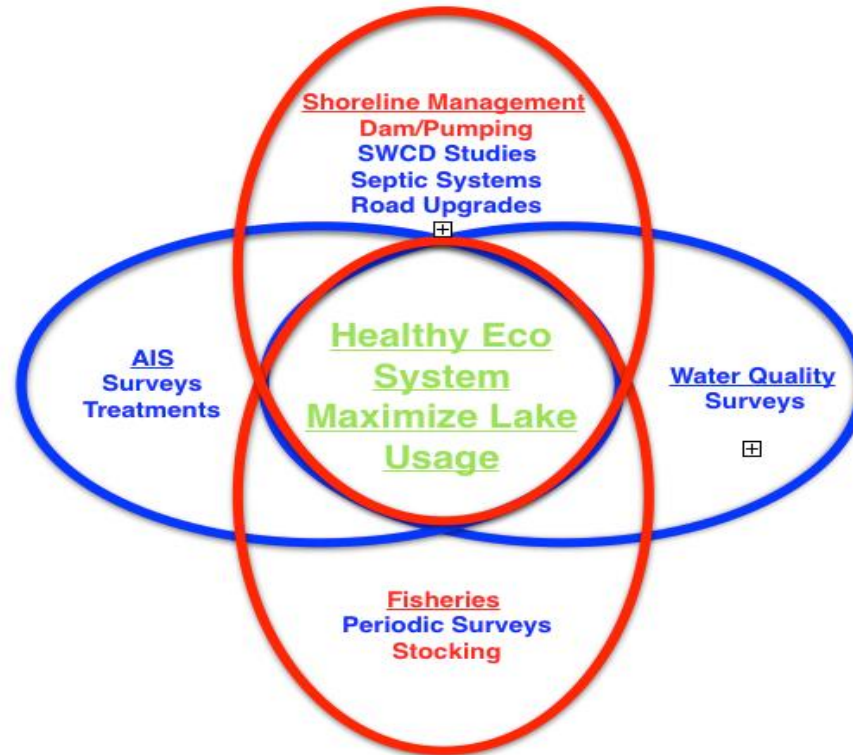

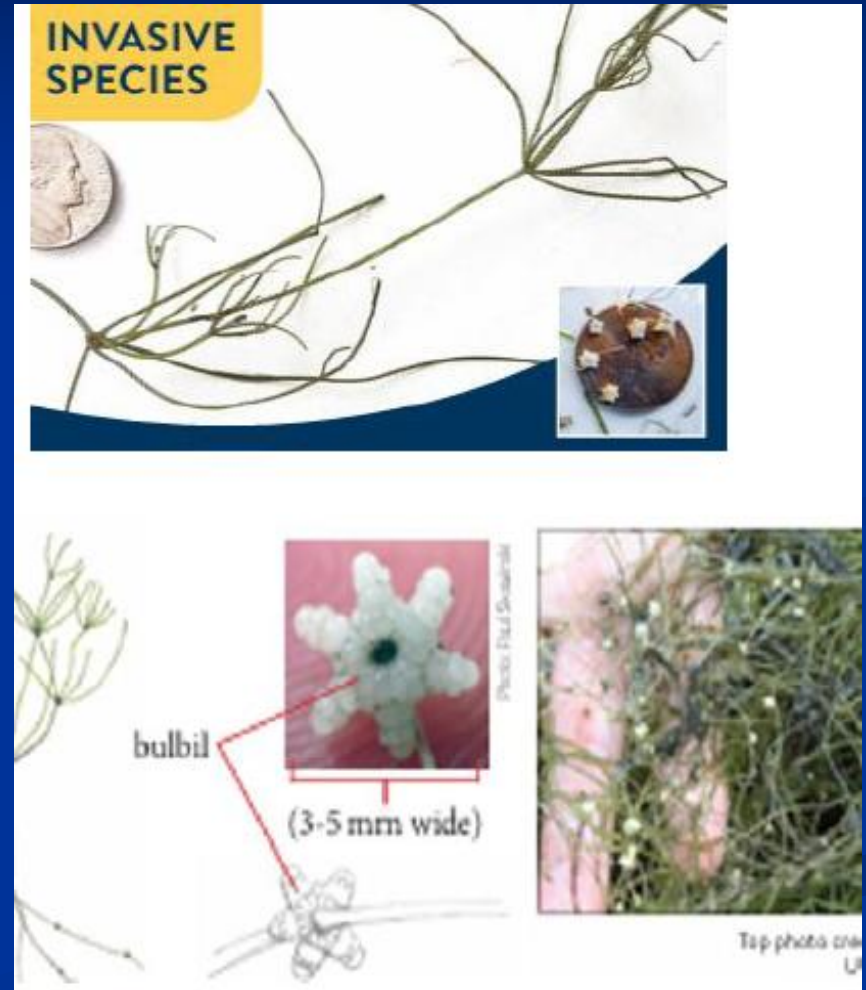

Starry Stonewort Search

- Starry Stonewort search
 - The 2025 search did not identify any Starry Stonewort (SS). Our contract surveyor also did not identify any SS.
 - Focused on shallow areas (perimeter of the west bay) and random locations around the lake.
 - Early August best time to search.
 - If you find any this year, snap a picture and send it to one of the Board members.



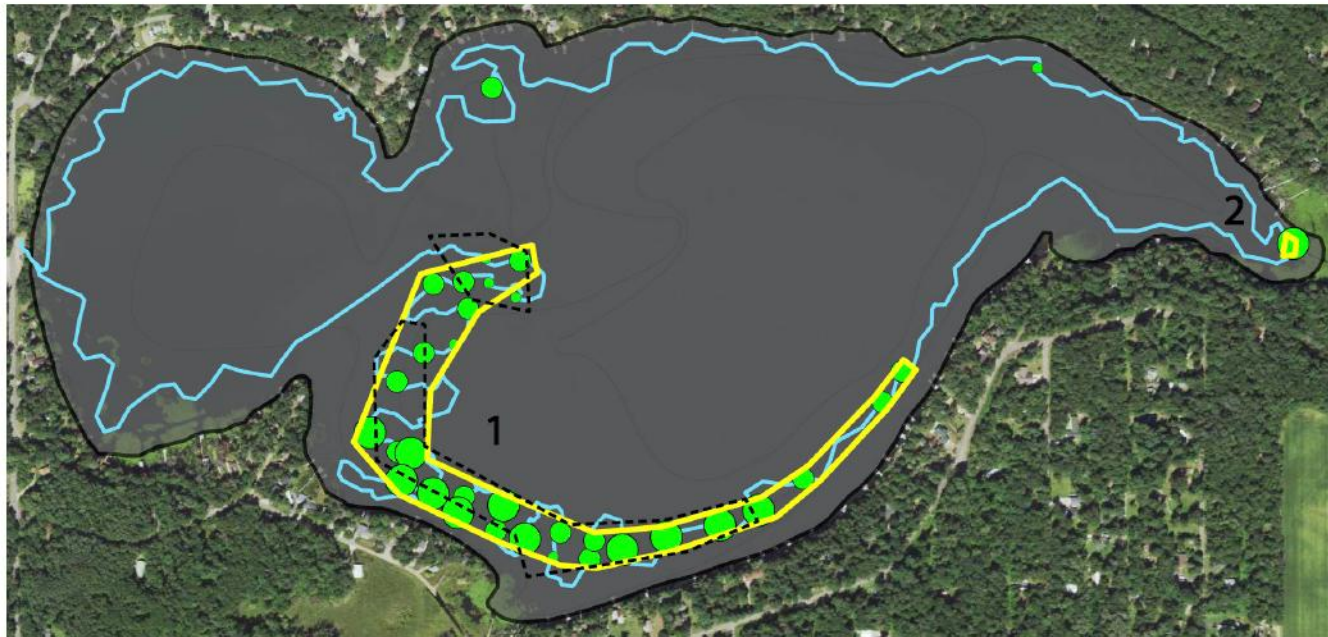

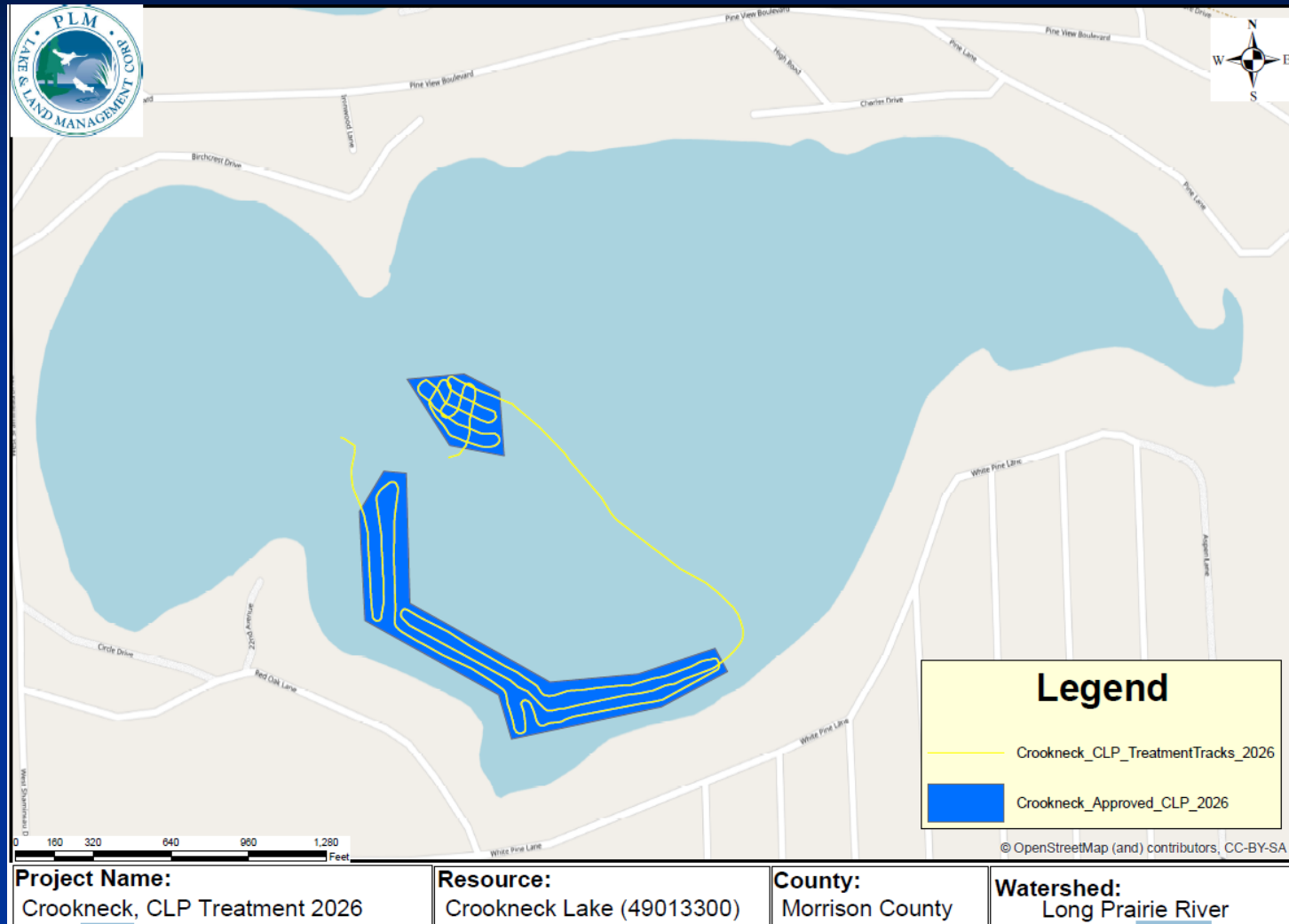

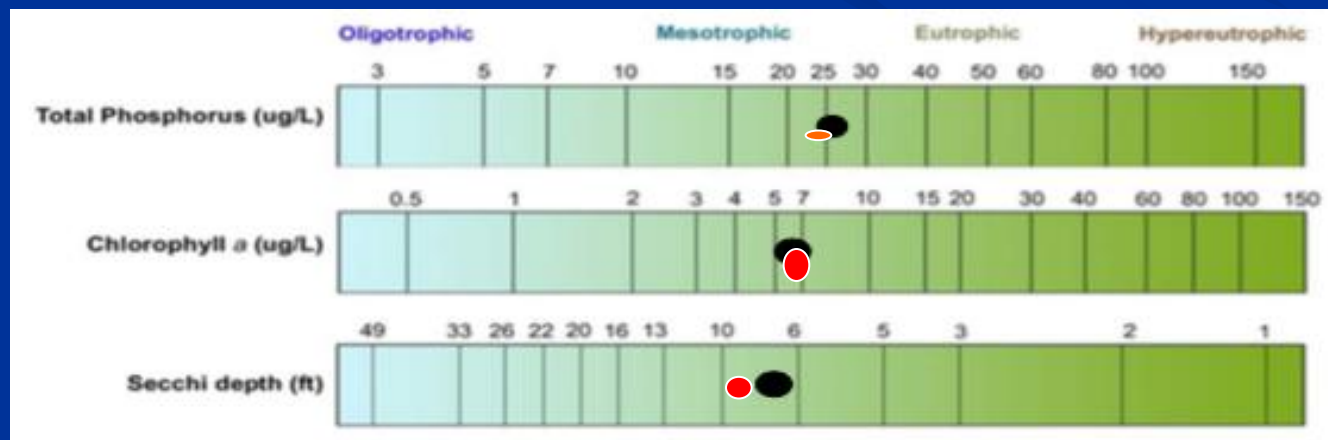
2026 CLP Treatment Zone (10.1 Acres Treated)

Zebra Mussel and Spiny Water Fleas Monitoring Program

- Zebra Mussel (veliger) and Spiny Water Fleas Testing
 - Funded by Morrison County
 - Samples collected various locations on the lake
 - June & July 2018 - 2025: Negative for both
 - June & July 2026: Pending

Water Quality Monitoring Program

- Analysis performed by RMB Laboratory
- Monthly samples May-Sep from two sites
- Analysis includes Total Phosphorus, Chlorophyll-a, and Secchi depth
- Lake Classification: Mesotrophic
- RMB labs ... Lakes Program ... Database

Annual Levy

The annual levy will now be set by the Board. Factors we consider while we set the levy for 2027 are:

- Treatment cost of Curly Leaf Pond Weed, Eurasian Water Milfoil, and Hybrid Milfoil
- The increased cost of Flumioxazin herbicide to treat CLP vs. alternative herbicide availability
- Likelihood of receiving an AIS grant
- A recommended cash balance of about 2 to 2 ½ times the yearly operating expenses
- Consideration of public input and comments

Annual Levy

- 2023 - 2026 levy: \$40 generated ~ \$5,400
- 2022 levy: \$60 levy generated ~ \$8,200
- Prior to the board setting the 2027 levy, I make a motion to open the meeting for public comment referencing the 2027 annual levy. Do I have a second?
 - Following comments, the board will set the 2027 levy.

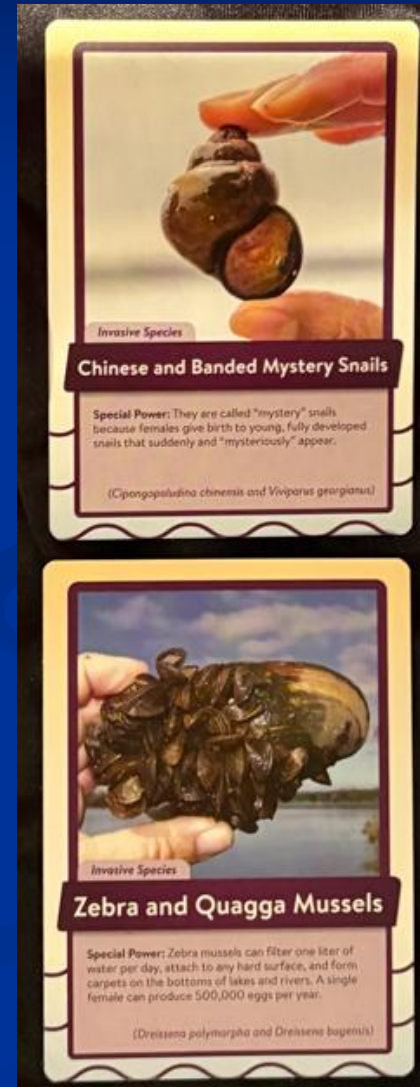

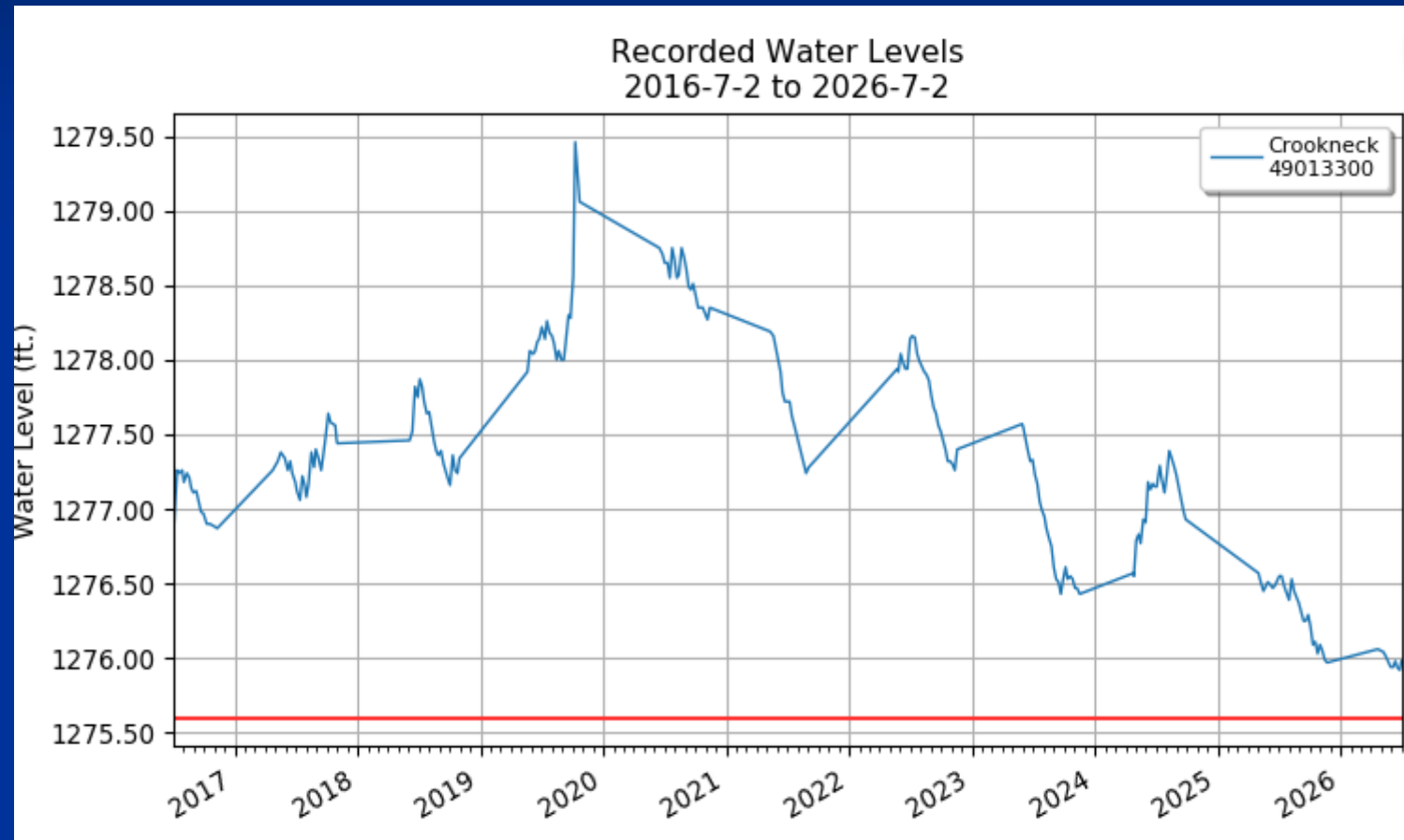
Watch Cards

- Chinese and Banded Mystery Snails vs. Zebra and Quagga Mussels Watch Cards
 - There is a large population of mystery snails across Crookneck Lake.
 - Zebra mussels (one pair) were identified at the lake access during Oct 2018.
 - No effective treatment to date.
 - ZMs are present in both Lake Alexander and FishTrap Lake.
 - Prevention for non-infested lakes is focused on “controlling hitchhikers”.



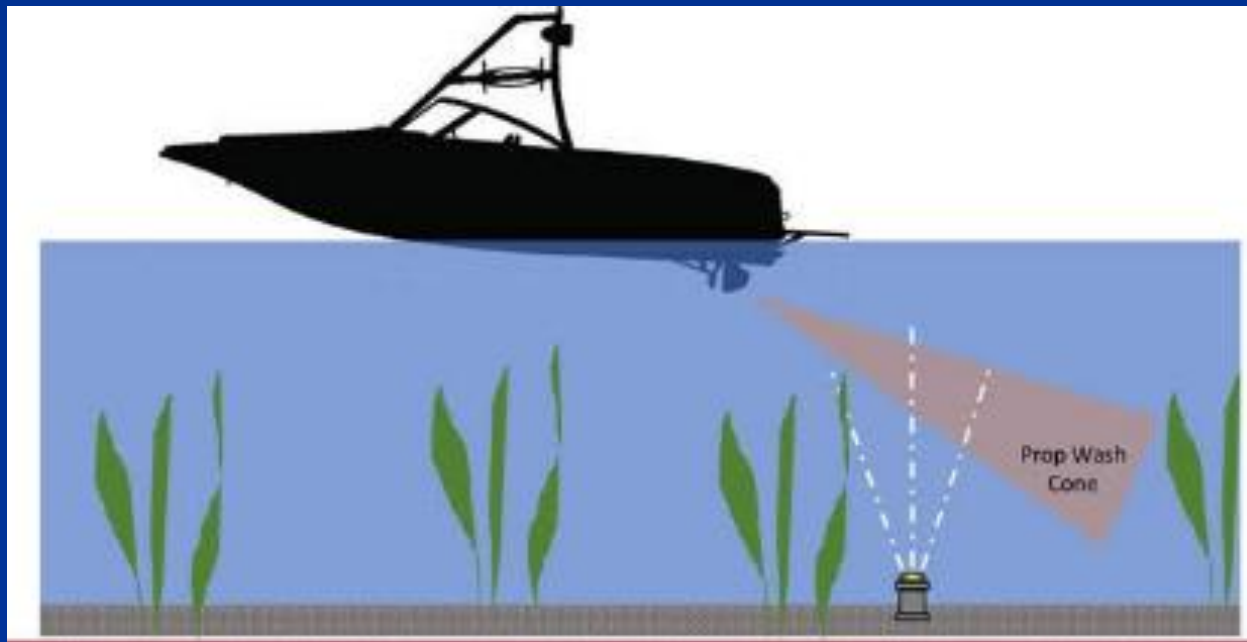
