Spring Meeting 2026**

JJ Parker called the spring meeting of the Lake Crookneck Improvement Association (LCIA) at 9:00, on May 24, 2026, following a coffee and donut social gathering.

There are two positions on the board of directors on the ballot for a 2-year term: one resident (homestead) member and one non-resident (seasonal) member.
