Find 10 soft toys or socks. Walk and count 20 steps and drop a toy every 2 steps. $10 \times 2 = 20$!



Try this again, but drop a toy or socks every 4 steps. Keep going to 20. How many did you drop?



Can you do the same thing with other numbers? Give it a try!



Share four snacks (like berries or crackers) equally with your grown-up. How many did you get each?

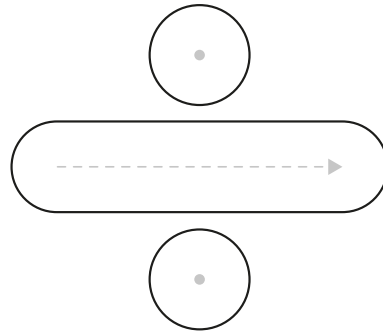

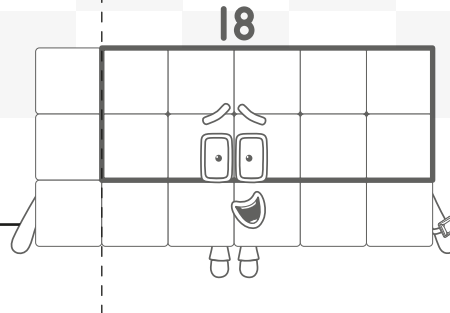

Try drawing the divide sign. It's a straight line with a dot above and below.



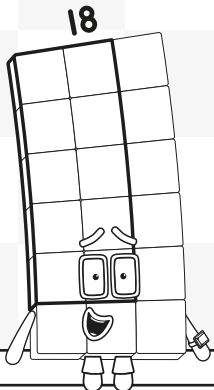
Split up!

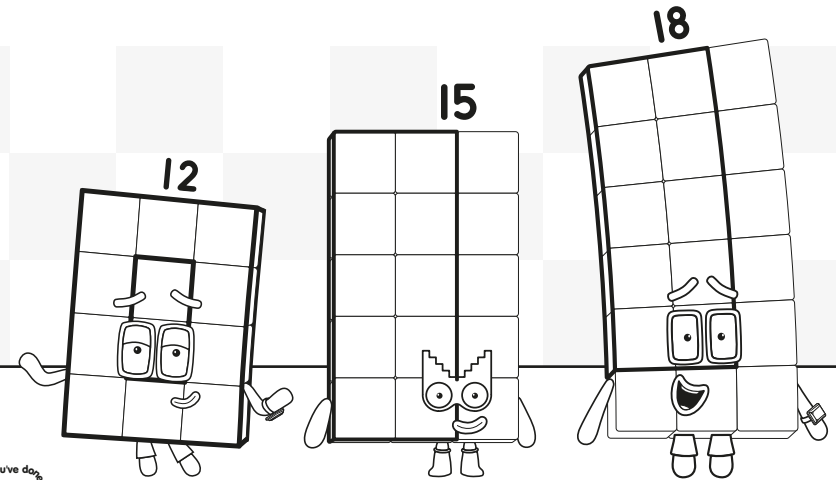
How many Sixes are in Numberblock Eighteen?
