Under Cover Numbers Game. Can you find smaller numbers hiding inside bigger ones? Cut out the Numberblocks on the extra sheet and find 26 small blocks or pieces of pasta. Pop the Numberblocks in a pile face down and take it in turns to pick one up. If you pick up Numberblock 18, pick up 18 blocks/pieces of pasta, and so on. Work with your little learner to split each number into equal groups. 18 can split into two nines, three sixes, six threes and nine twos. How many different ways can you split each number?




