Find a pair of socks. How many socks is that? Find another pair. How many now? Keep finding pairs until you have 10 pairs of socks.

Check by counting in twos.





Look out for pairs of things at home or when you are out. Cheer when you've found ten pairs of things.





Try making 10 jumps, counting in twos each time. "2, 4, 6 ..." can you get all the way to 20?





Go back the way you came. See if you can count backwards in twos starting from 20. "20, 18, 16..." Can you get back to 2?

**Tremendous Twos.** Cut out the Numberblocks and use them to help your little learner with the questions. When you're done, you can use your Numberblocks to practise the two times table.






### How Many Twos?

How many Twos make Ten? Find out by making your own Ten with the Numberblock Twos!






Draw lines to split Twenty into Twos. Use your Numberblock Twos and check if you got it right!





