Can you make your own pretend sandcastle using items around your home? You could use recycling or toys, or something else! How many items are in your castle altogether? Is this number in the Four Times Table?



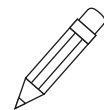

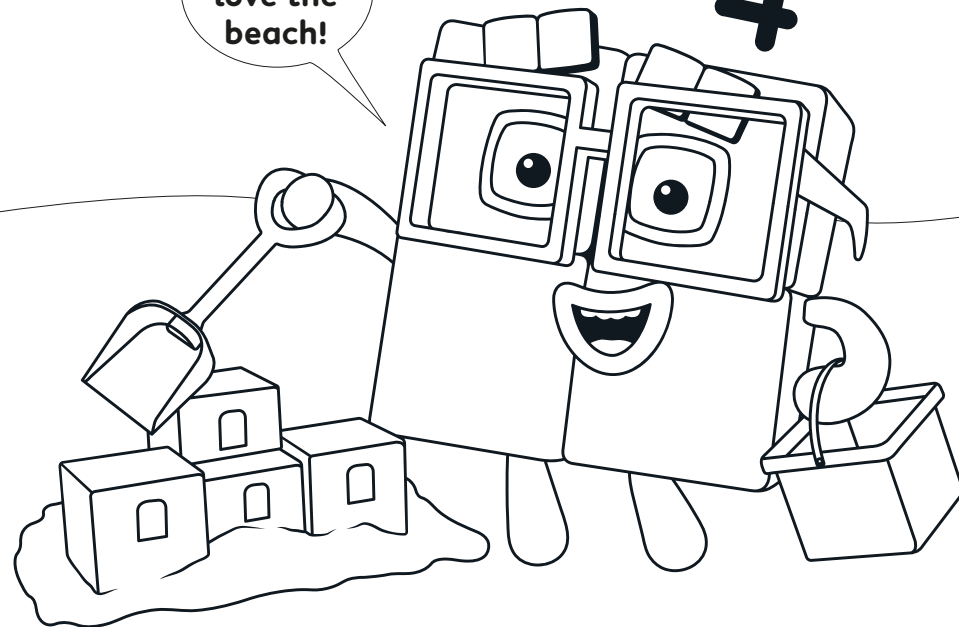

Write the numbers on the doors too!

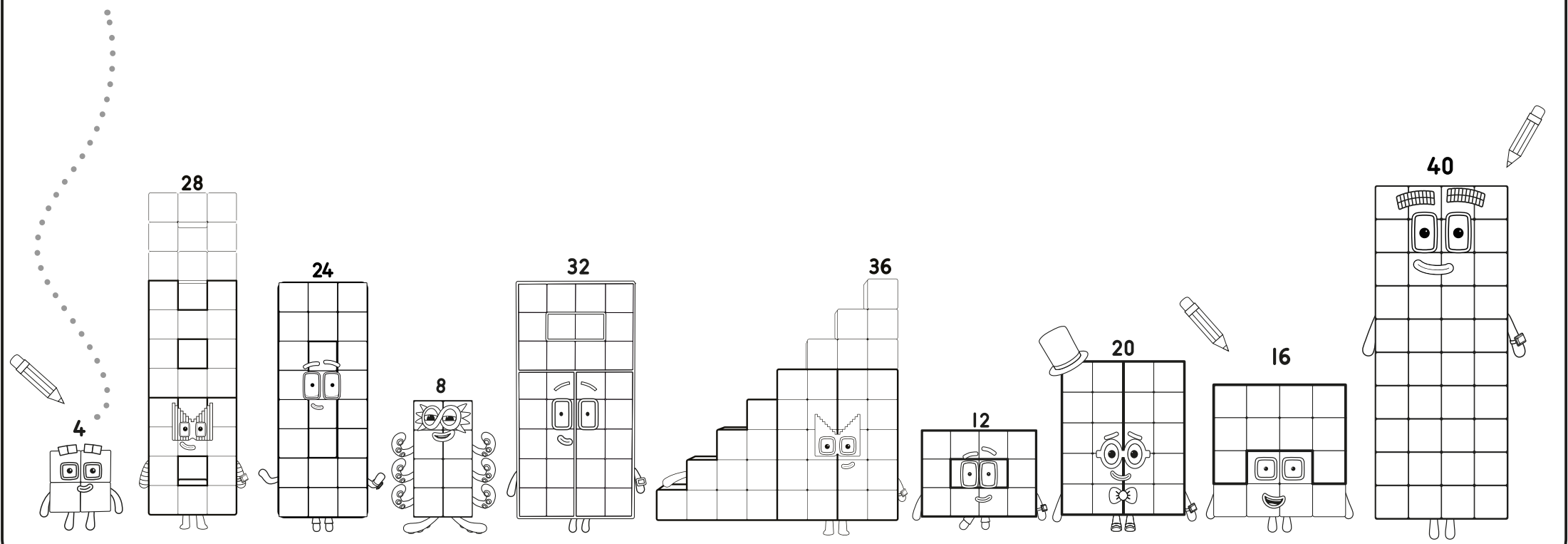
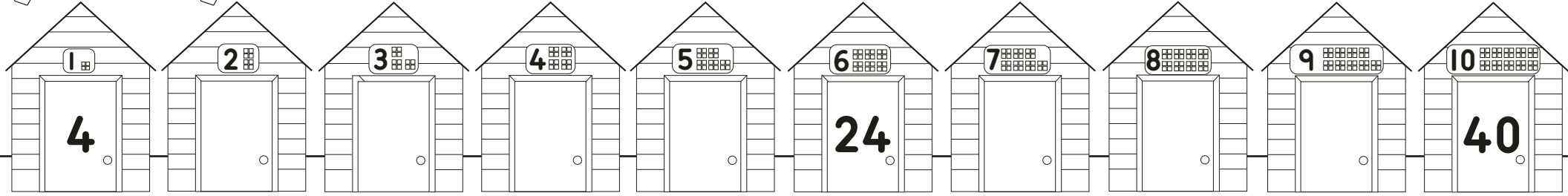
Look! This beach hut belongs to Numberblock Four!
