

Number Explorer Missions





Line up 20 pebbles on the ground in 2 rows of 10 to make your own rekenrek. Can you use it to add things together, like red and black cars, or big and small dogs?





Write numbers between I and IO on pieces of paper. Make sure you have 2 of each number. Pop the numbers in a hat, pick out 2 numbers and use your Rekenrek to add the numbers together.





Play shop with your grown-up! Add price tags to toys and books, and take it in turns who plays the shop keeper and who is the shopper. Add the prices together on your Rekenrek.

Try playing bowling too. Place 10 cardboard tubes and throw a scrunched up ball of paper (or roll a ball if you have one) to knock the cardboard tubes down. Each player has two goes. How many points can you collect? Use Rekenrek to add it up!





Rekenrek's ready! When all the coloured beads are pushed to the left on the top bar, it means 5.




2 more beads are pushed to the left on the bottom bar.


