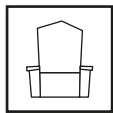
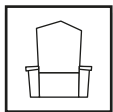


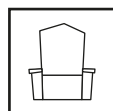
Colour Explorer Missions



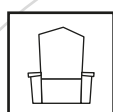
