**Take some giant Ten Steps and count as each foot steps forward: 10, 20, 30, 40, 50!**



**Draw a big flower with 10 petals. Can you draw 4 more? How many petals do you have altogether?**



**Use the fingers on one hand to count in 10s up to 50.**



## Play Together

More Tens! Cut out the Numberblocks and place Numberblock Twenty in your playspace. Ask your little learner to add a Numberblock Ten and say how many blocks there are in total. Repeat, adding Tens until you get to 50. If your little learner is confident, try calling out numbers to make - 20, 30, 40 or 50.
