Can you reverse the Ten in the Bed song? Start with 1 Numberblob, and instead of singing 'and one fell out', sing 'and one jumped in'. Keep going until you get to 10 Numberblobs.



Why not stick the bed from your booklet onto a cardboard box? You could make little pillows by wrapping tissue paper around cotton wool, and use tissue paper for the quilt.



Ask your grown-up to write up some adding and taking away puzzles on little pieces of note paper. Make sure they don't go higher than 10 and place them in a pile. Pull out one note at a time, and use the Numberblobs bed to work out the answer!



Ask your grown-up to add some Numberblobs to the bed. Can you tell your grown-up how many are in the bed without counting them? Remember, there are 5 in each row!



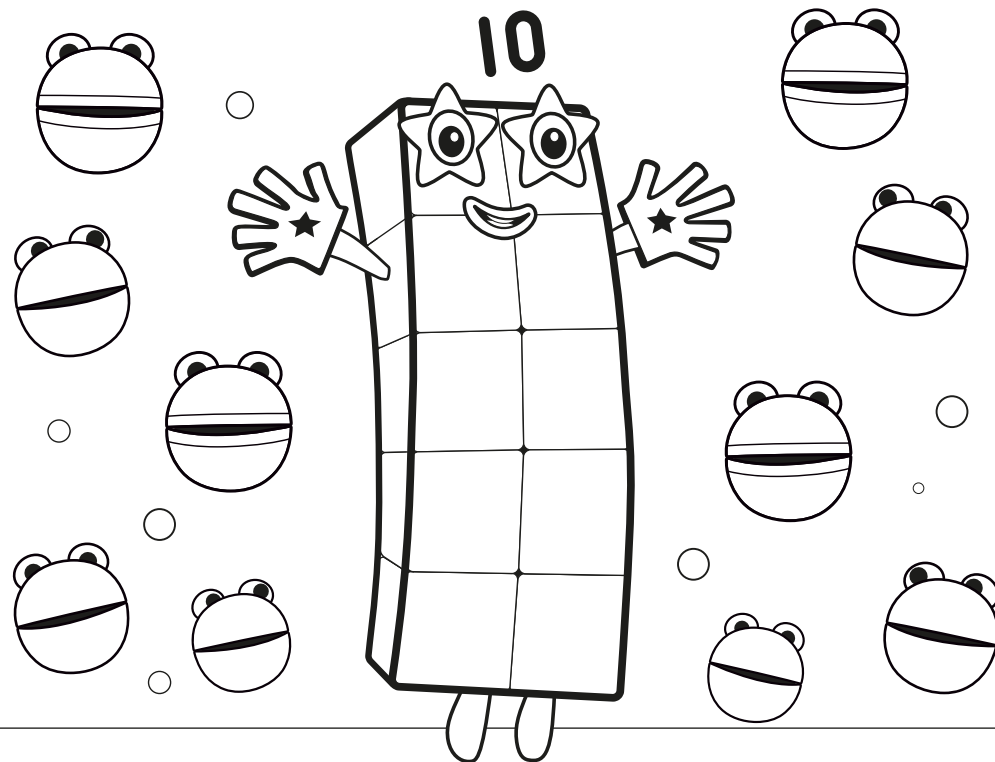

Remove them one at a time as you sing along to Ten in the Bed.

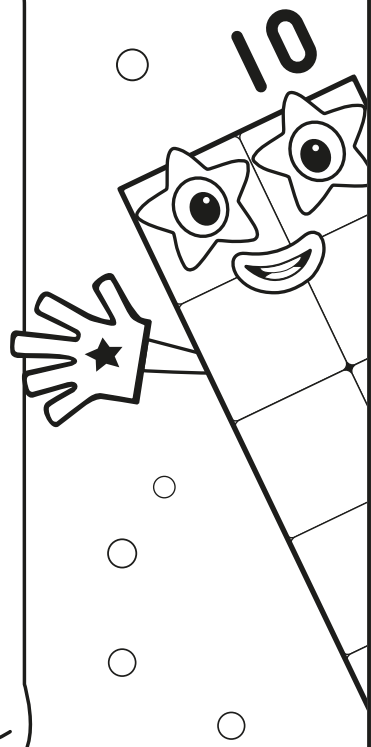
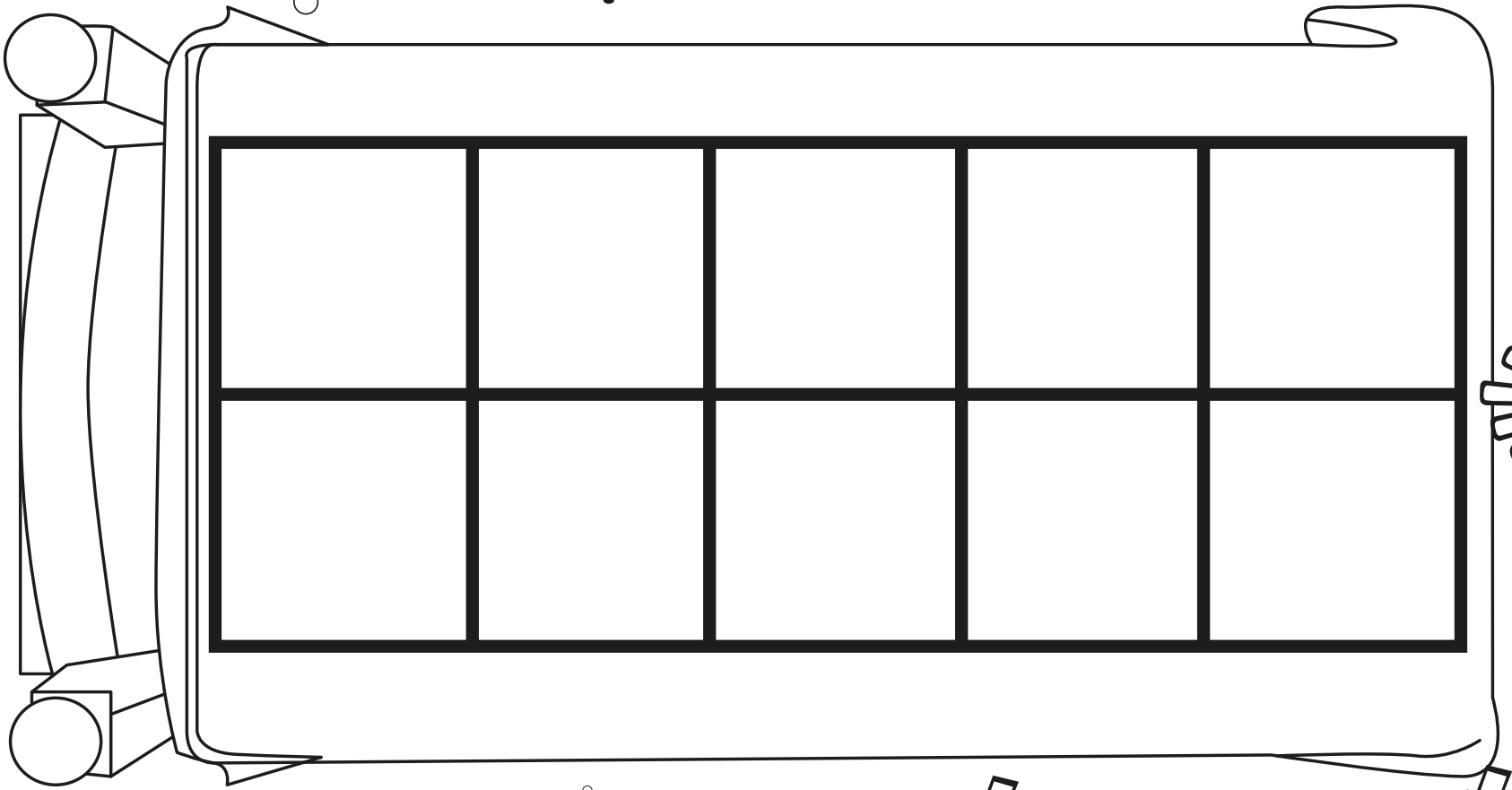
