For your next mission, find the episode 'Octoblock and the Path of Justice'.

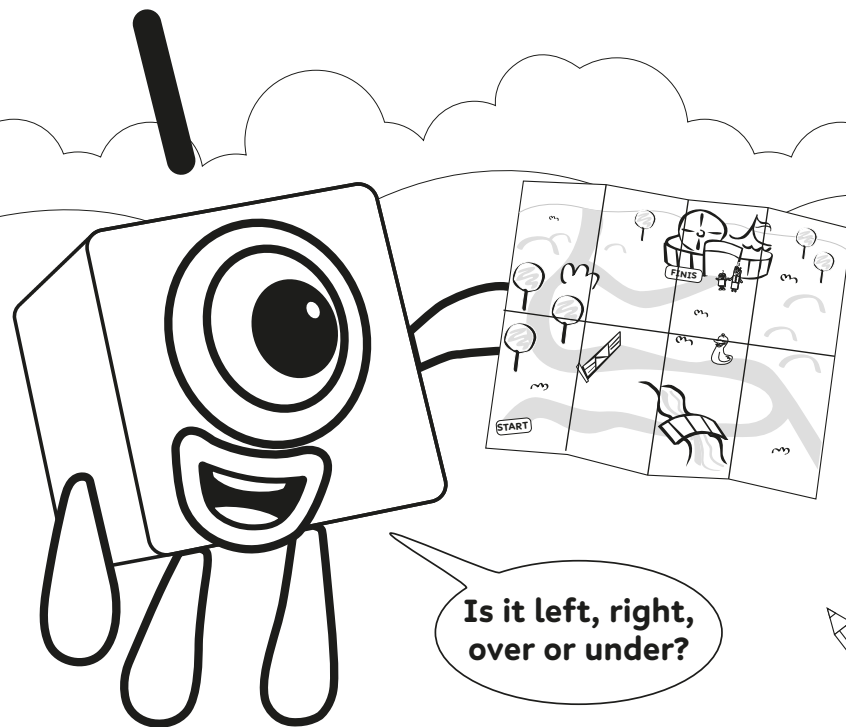

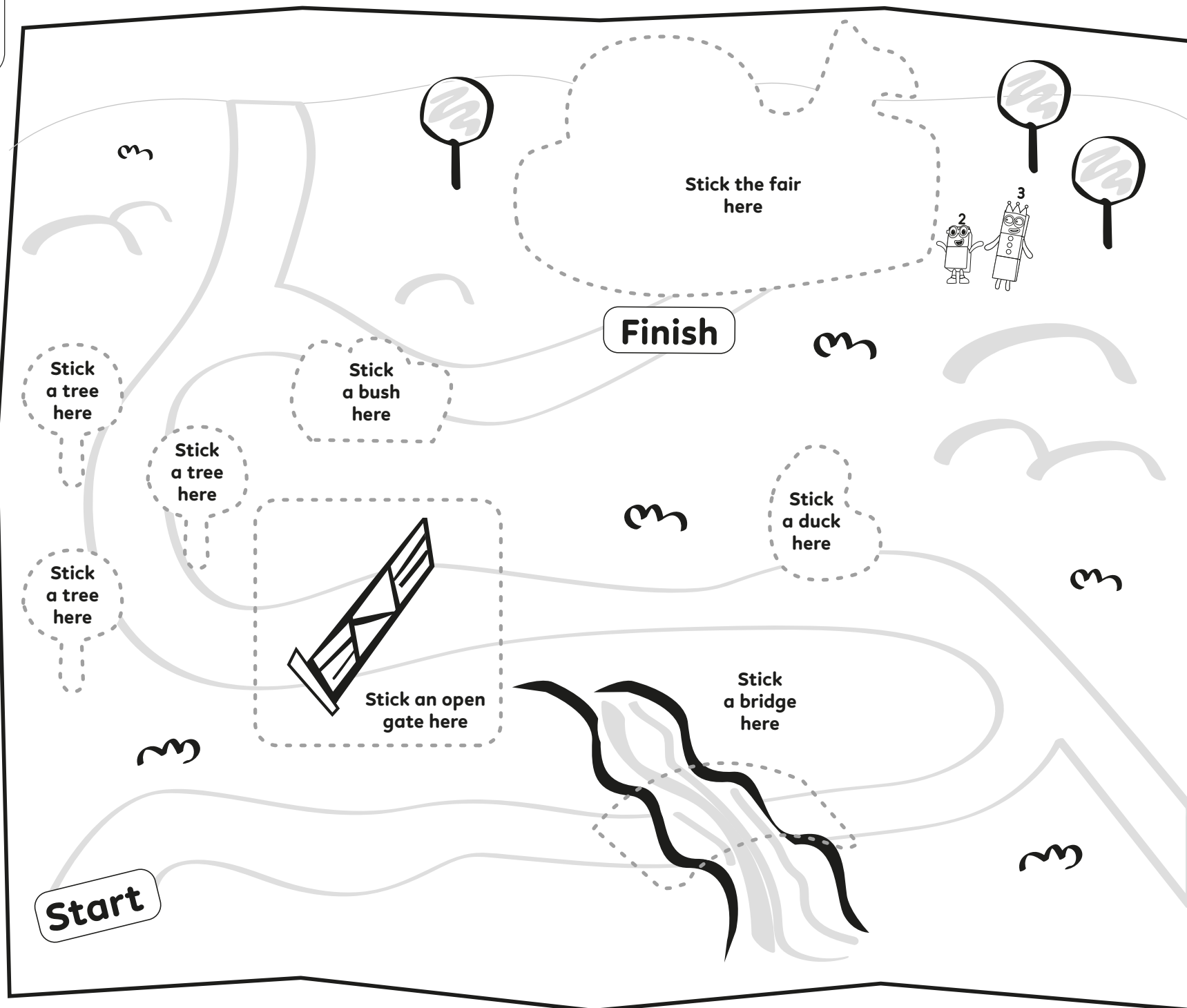
# One's map

## How to play

2. Turn... (right) or (left) at the junction.
3. There's a gate! Go (through) or (over) the gate.
4. Follow the path (between) or (under) the trees.
5. Turn... (left) or (right) around the bush.
6. The Numberblock Fair is (up ahead) or (behind you)
