Are you a brave Number Explorer too? Go on an adventure with your grown-up around where you live! Can you spot any numbers? Look on front doors, street signs, buses and cars.







100-by-10 Grid



Can you find a Numberblock to fit into each empty space? Cut them out from your extra sheet.



Look! Each times table goes both across and down.




Did you know? The Numberblocks can switch around to fit in different slots. For example, Fourteen can be 2×7 or 7×2 .


Colour in each Times Table as you fill each row or column in the grid.
