



Colour Explorer Missions




Use soft crayons to draw a rainbow on white card. Smudge the colours together with your finger or a piece of kitchen towel. Can you see any new colours appearing in between each stripe?



Chase the rainbow, like Indigo and Violet. Can you find things that are rainbow coloured, or nearly all rainbow coloured? If an object is red, orange and yellow, can you name the colours missing to make it a rainbow?



Mix some dish soap and water, and have fun blowing bubbles outside on a sunny day. Look closely at your bubbles, can you see the shifting rainbow colours on the surface of them?




Find a sponge, some paint and white card. Protect your table top with newspaper, and wear an apron too. Blob paint onto the sponge in the order of the rainbow. Now drag it across white card to create your own colourful rainbow!





