Have lots of fun making some simple voting forms. Draw your two favourite biscuits or two favourite animals for example, on sheets of paper. Then everyone gets to tick their vote!



Now try a different way to vote. Find toys in different colours. Give your friends or family members a building block in those colours. Each person votes for their favourite colour by putting a block next to the toy that matches its colour. Tell your grown-up which toy has the most votes!



## Play Together

Make a box to put some important votes in! Decorate the box and put a slot in the top. Draw what you're voting for on paper for each person, for example, three dinner choices. Put the votes in the box, no peeking at the other votes! Then take them out and put them in separate piles to see the winning vote.

# Vote Time

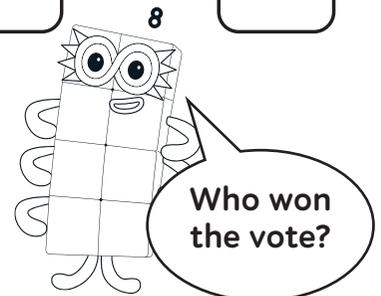
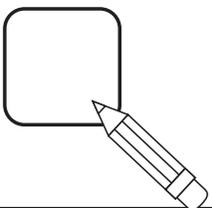
The Numberblocks are choosing what to do, with a vote.
