Make your own Fraction Island on a blanket. Divide it into four quarters and put toys and books in each quarter. Don't forget to put the same number of things in each quarter.



Build a tall tower of building blocks, then build one that's half its size. Can you build another tower that's one third of the tallest tower?



Collect lots of fallen twigs and line them up. Find the biggest twig and then see if you can find twigs that are half, a third and a quarter of its size.






Two new friends!


I'm one half!

Say hello to the Thirds!



Here are the Quarters, they can be called fourths too!





Whole


You've found the Fraction Friends and made the island one whole again, just like the map!
