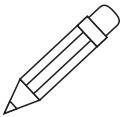
Play Together

For your next mission, find the episode 'Now You See Us'.

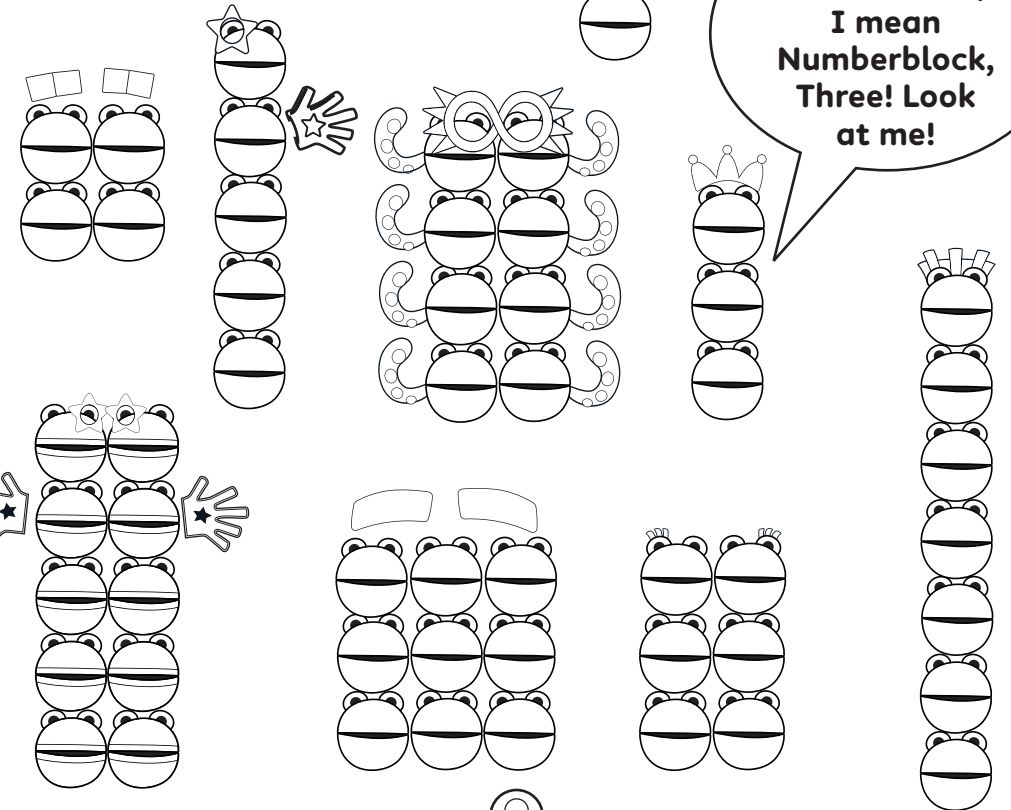
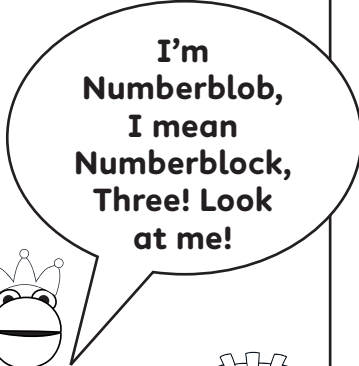
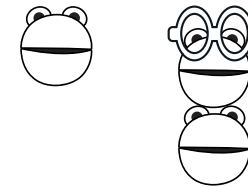

Let's try some Number Magic with the Numberblobs!

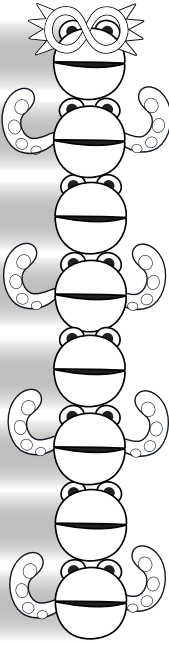
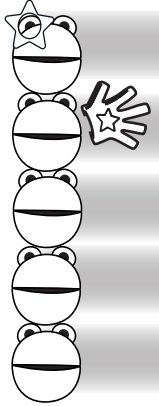
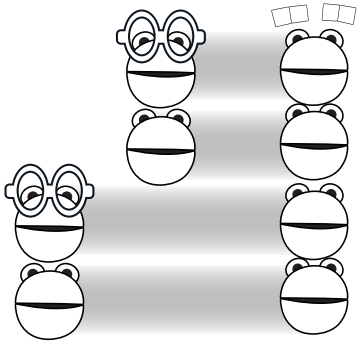
1 + 1 =
