 describe it? Is the **thing** **thick** or **thin**?



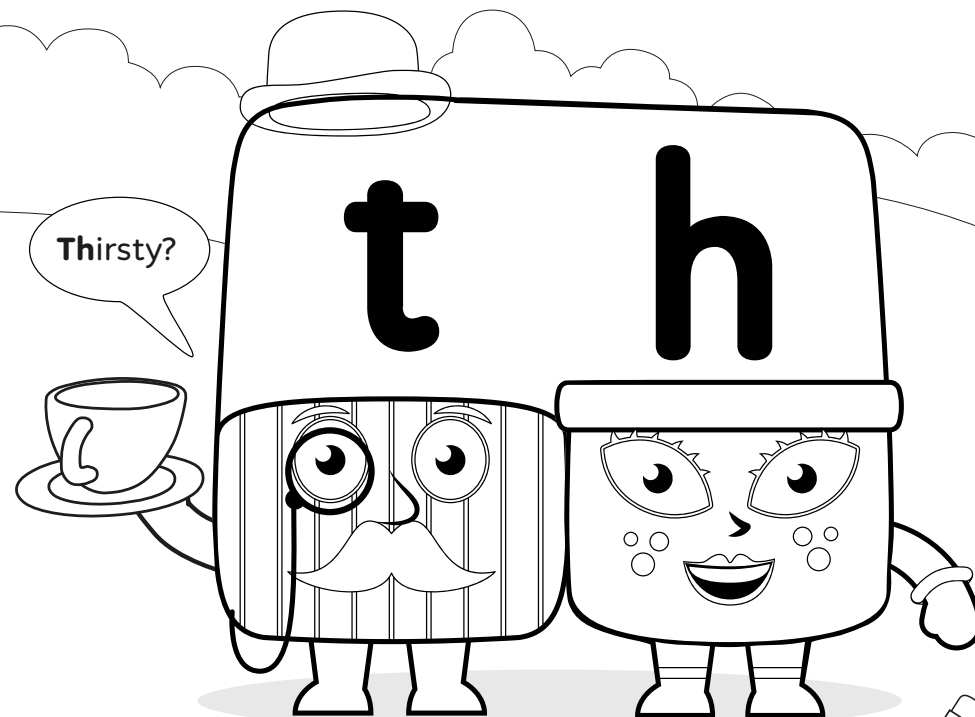

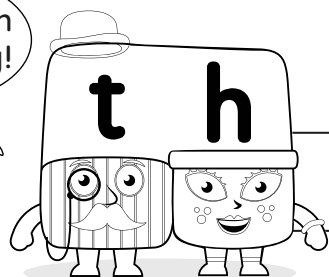
Thick thing, thin thing

That is an odd **thing**!



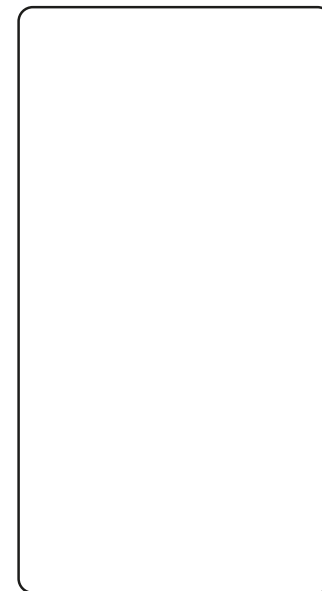
Did you know? Th makes two sounds. One is **th** like **thick**. The other is **th** like **that**.

That is a **thin thing**. →





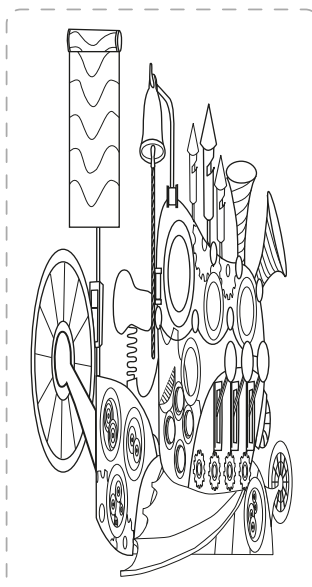
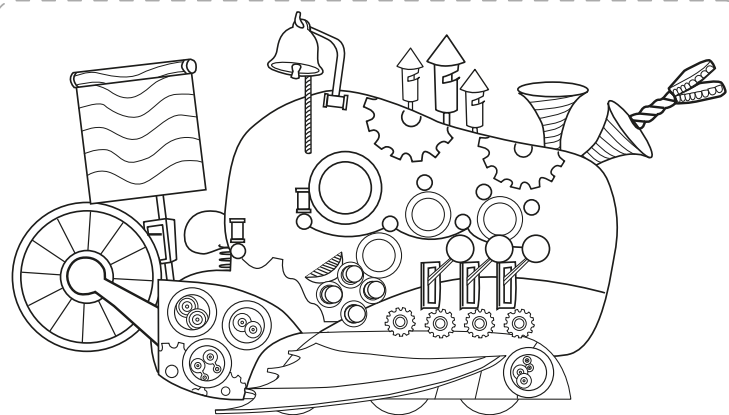
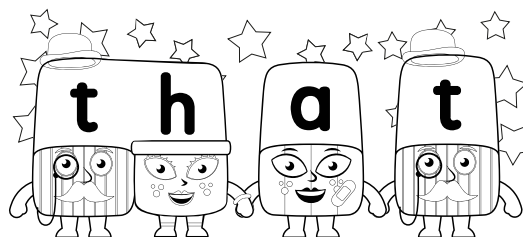
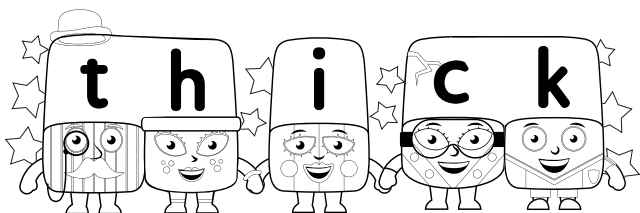
Play Together

Thick or that?

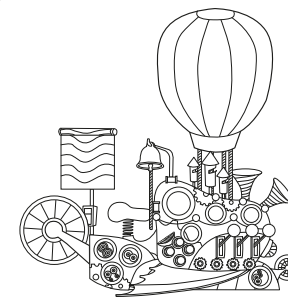
Cut out the cards and give them to your little learner.

Here are some words you can use: **this, that, thick, thin, them, thing, bath.**



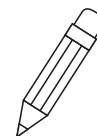
