Instructions

1. The *Borrower Certification of Property Condition* form must be completed and signed by the Borrower.
2. For VA loans, the Veteran must complete the *VA Certification of Property Condition* in lieu of the *Borrower Certification of Property Condition*.
3. The purpose of the *Borrower Certification of Property Condition* is to certify that an exterior inspection has been performed on the subject property and the neighborhood in which it is located. Current photographs may be requested once the form has been submitted that show the following aspects of the subject property:
 - a. Front of the subject property
 - b. Address verification (photo to include home with house number)
